INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the PowRyte Elite Electric Power Washer. This powerful cleaning tool is designed to efficiently tackle heavy-duty cleaning jobs around your home, including vehicles, decks, driveways, and more. This manual provides essential information for the safe operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your pressure washer. Please read it thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always observe basic safety precautions when using this product to reduce the risk of injury or damage. High-pressure spray can cause serious injury.

- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment, including eye protection, when operating the pressure washer.
- Never point the spray gun at people, pets, or electrical devices.
- Ensure all connections are secure before starting the unit.
- Do not operate the pressure washer if the power cord or hose is damaged.
- Keep children and pets away from the operating area.
- The unit features a Total Stop System (TSS) which automatically shuts off the pump when the trigger is not engaged. This saves energy and prolongs pump life.

- Use only UL listed extension cords suitable for outdoor use and the power requirements of the unit.

COMPONENTS AND FEATURES

Your PowRyte Elite Pressure Washer comes equipped with several features designed for effective cleaning:

- **Powerful Motor:** 1800 Watt copper motor generating max 4000 PSI at 3.0 GPM.
- **Quick-Connect Spray Tips:** Includes 5 different tips (0°, 15°, 25°, 40°, and soap) for various cleaning tasks.
- **Detergent Tank:** Integrated soap quick-connector and detergent tank for applying cleaning solutions.
- **High-Pressure Hose:** 20 ft high-pressure hose with quick-connectors.
- **Power Cord:** 35 ft power cord with UL listed plug for extended reach and safety.
- **Total Stop System (TSS):** Automatically shuts off the pump when the trigger is not engaged.

SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure all parts listed in the packing list (refer to your product box) are present.
2. **Assembly:**
 - Attach the handle to the main unit if it is not pre-assembled.
 - Secure the wheels if they are separate.
 - Mount the spray gun holder and nozzle storage rack.
3. **Connecting Water Supply:**
 - Connect a garden hose (not included) to the water inlet on the pressure washer. Ensure the connection is tight to prevent leaks.
 - Connect the other end of the garden hose to a water faucet.
 - Turn on the water supply completely before starting the pressure washer to purge air from the system.
4. **Connecting High-Pressure Hose and Spray Gun:**
 - Connect one end of the 20 ft high-pressure hose to the high-pressure outlet on the pressure washer.
 - Connect the other end of the high-pressure hose to the spray gun.
 - Ensure both connections are securely tightened.
5. **Connecting Power:**
 - Uncoil the 35 ft power cord completely.
 - Plug the UL listed plug into a grounded electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Selecting a Spray Tip:** Choose one of the 5 quick-connect spray tips based on your cleaning needs:
 - **0° (Red):** Pin-point jet for stubborn spots. Use with extreme caution.
 - **15° (Yellow):** High-pressure, narrow spray for intense cleaning of small areas.
 - **25° (Green):** Medium-pressure, wider spray for general cleaning.
 - **40° (White):** Low-pressure, wide spray for delicate surfaces or rinsing.
 - **Soap (Black):** For applying detergent at low pressure.

To change tips, pull back the collar on the spray gun and insert the desired tip until it clicks into place.

2. Starting the Pressure Washer:

- Ensure water supply is fully open.
- Squeeze the trigger on the spray gun to release any trapped air and allow water to flow through the system for about 30 seconds.
- Turn the power switch to the "ON" position. The motor will start.
- Release the trigger to engage the Total Stop System (TSS). The motor will stop.

3. Applying Detergent:

- Fill the detergent tank with appropriate pressure washer detergent.
- Attach the black soap tip to the spray gun.
- Squeeze the trigger. The pressure washer will automatically draw detergent and mix it with water at low pressure.
- Apply detergent to the surface to be cleaned, allowing it to soak for a few minutes (do not let it dry).
- Switch to a high-pressure tip (e.g., 15° or 25°) to rinse the surface thoroughly.

4. Shutting Down:

- Turn the power switch to the "OFF" position.
- Turn off the water supply.
- Squeeze the spray gun trigger to release any remaining pressure in the system.
- Disconnect the garden hose and high-pressure hose.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your pressure washer.

- **Cleaning Nozzles:** If a nozzle becomes clogged, use the included nozzle cleaning tool (or a small wire) to clear any debris. Rinse thoroughly.
- **Water Inlet Filter:** Regularly check and clean the water inlet filter to prevent debris from entering the pump.
- **Hose and Cord Inspection:** Before each use, inspect the high-pressure hose and power cord for any signs of damage, kinks, or wear. Replace if damaged.
- **Storage:**
 - Drain all water from the pump, hose, and spray gun before storing.
 - Store the pressure washer in a dry, frost-free area.
 - For prolonged storage or in freezing temperatures, use a pump protector/antifreeze solution specifically designed for pressure washers.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the table below for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Motor does not start	Power cord not plugged in; Circuit breaker tripped; Power switch OFF.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in; Reset circuit breaker; Turn power switch ON.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No water pressure or low pressure	Water supply off; Kink in garden hose; Clogged water inlet filter; Clogged nozzle; Air in pump.	Turn on water supply; Straighten hose; Clean water inlet filter; Clean nozzle; Purge air by running water through gun with motor off.
Pulsating pressure	Air in pump; Clogged nozzle; Water supply restriction.	Purge air from pump; Clean nozzle; Check water supply for kinks or blockages.
Detergent not siphoning	Detergent tank empty; Black soap nozzle not attached; Clogged detergent tube.	Fill detergent tank; Attach black soap nozzle; Clean detergent tube.
