3. SETUP

- Remove the fire pit and stand from its packaging.
- Place the fire pit on a stable, non-combustible surface, ensuring adequate clearance from any overhead structures or surrounding flammable materials.

3.2 Component Assembly

The Bonfire typically comes with a removable ash pan and base for easy cleanup. The stand is designed to elevate the fire pit, protecting the surface beneath.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for a successful and enjoyable fire pit experience.

4.1 Building a Fire

- Place kindling (small dry sticks, paper, or fire starters) at the bottom of the fire pit.
- Arrange small pieces of firewood in a teepee or log cabin style over the kindling.
- Light the kindling. Once the smaller wood catches fire, gradually add larger logs.
- For optimal smokeless performance, ensure wood is dry and kept below the top vents.

4.2 Adding Wood

Add firewood as needed to maintain your desired flame. Use caution when adding wood to an active fire.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and continued performance of your Solo Stove Bonfire.

5.1 Putting Out the Fire

- Allow the fire to burn down naturally. Do not use water to extinguish the fire, as this can damage the stainless steel and create a muddy mess.
- Once only hot coals remain, you may use a Solo Stove lid (sold separately) to cover the fire pit, which helps to contain embers and accelerate cooling.

5.2 Cleaning and Storage

- After the fire pit has completely cooled, remove the ash pan and dispose of the ashes responsibly.
- Wipe down the exterior with a damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could scratch the stainless steel.

- Store the fire pit in a dry location, ideally covered with a Solo Stove cover (sold separately) to protect it from the elements.

6. ACCESSORIES

Enhance your Solo Stove Bonfire experience with official accessories:

- **Stand:** Elevates the fire pit to protect surfaces.
- **Lid:** Covers the fire pit to protect embers and keep out debris.
- **Heat Deflector:** Directs heat outwards for increased warmth.
- **Shelter:** Weather-resistant cover for protection when not in use.
- **Roasting Sticks:** For cooking marshmallows and other treats.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Excessive Smoke:** Ensure only dry, seasoned firewood is used. Avoid wet or green wood. Keep wood below the top air vents for optimal secondary combustion.
- **Difficulty Lighting:** Use ample kindling and a reliable fire starter. Ensure good airflow by arranging wood properly.
- **Low Heat Output:** The double-wall design directs heat upwards. Consider a heat deflector accessory for increased horizontal heat distribution.

- **Ash Accumulation:** Regularly empty the removable ash pan to maintain proper airflow and burning efficiency.
