1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Alesis Virtue AHP-1W Digital Piano. Please read these instructions thoroughly before using the instrument to ensure proper function and longevity.



2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Verify that all the following items are included in your package:

- Virtue Digital Piano
- Piano Stand with Music Rest and 3 Pedals
- Adjustable Piano Bench
- Assembly Parts
- Power Adapter
- User Guide (this document)
- Safety & Warranty Manual

3. SETUP

3.1 Assembly

The Alesis Virtue AHP-1W Digital Piano requires assembly of the stand, pedals, and bench. Follow the detailed instructions provided in the separate Assembly Parts guide. Ensure all screws and fasteners are securely tightened for stability.

3.2 Power Connection

1. Connect the included Power Adapter to the DC IN port on the rear of the digital piano.
2. Plug the Power Adapter into a standard electrical outlet.

3.3 Audio and Data Connections

The Alesis Virtue AHP-1W offers various connectivity options:

- **Stereo 1/4-inch Output:** For connecting to external amplifiers, mixers, or recording interfaces.
- **MIDI In & Out:** For connecting to MIDI devices such as sound modules, computers, or other keyboards.
- **USB Output:** For connecting the piano to a computer for MIDI data transfer.
- **Thumb Drive Input:** For playing back or recording audio files via a USB flash drive.
- **Auxiliary Input:** For connecting external audio sources like MP3 players.

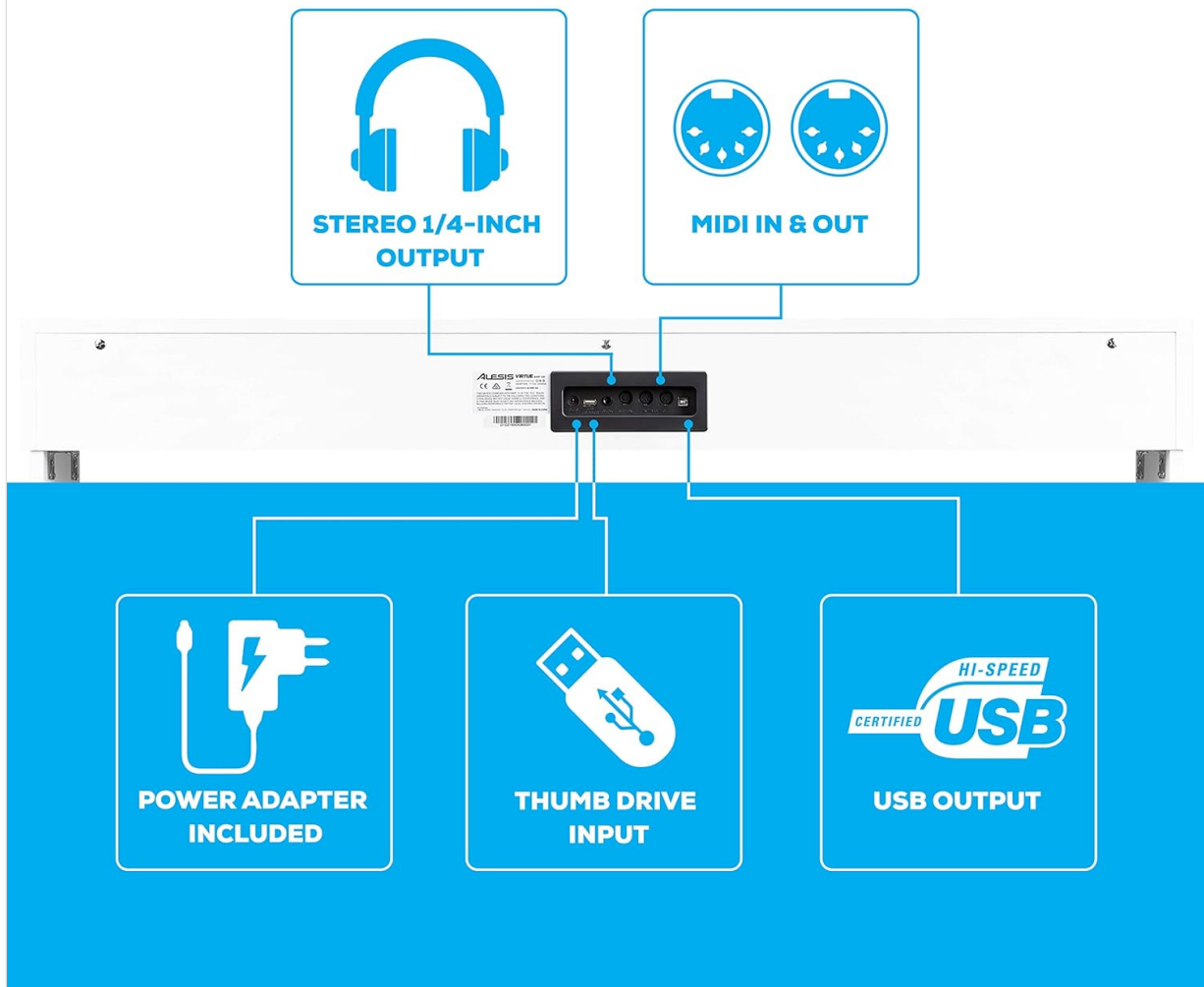

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Basic Operation

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the Power button located on the control panel to turn the instrument on or off.
2. **Volume Control:** Adjust the Master Volume knob to set the overall output level of the built-in speakers or connected headphones.

4.2 Voices and Tones

The Alesis Virtue AHP-1W features 360 built-in premium voices. Use the dedicated voice selection buttons or the data dial to browse and select different instrument sounds, including acoustic pianos, electric pianos, organs, strings, and more.

- **Layer Mode:** Combine two different voices to play simultaneously when a key is pressed. Refer to the full user guide for specific instructions on activating and adjusting layer mode.
- **Split Mode:** Divide the keyboard into two sections, each with a different voice. This allows for playing two different instruments with the left and right hands.

4.3 Educational Features and Modes

The digital piano includes several features designed to assist with learning and practice:

- **Lesson Mode:** Divides the 88-key keyboard into two identical sections with the same pitch and voice, facilitating practice with a teacher or another student.
- **Metronome:** A built-in metronome with an adjustable tempo range (30-280 BPM) helps maintain rhythm and timing during practice.
- **One-Touch Song Mode:** Access 160 built-in accompaniment styles. The backlit LCD screen displays chord names and notation.
- **Demo Songs:** Features 80 demo songs for listening and learning.
- **Record Mode:** Allows users to record their performances and play them back for review.
- **Skoove Lessons:** The product includes a 3-month premium subscription to Skoove, an online platform offering interactive piano lessons.

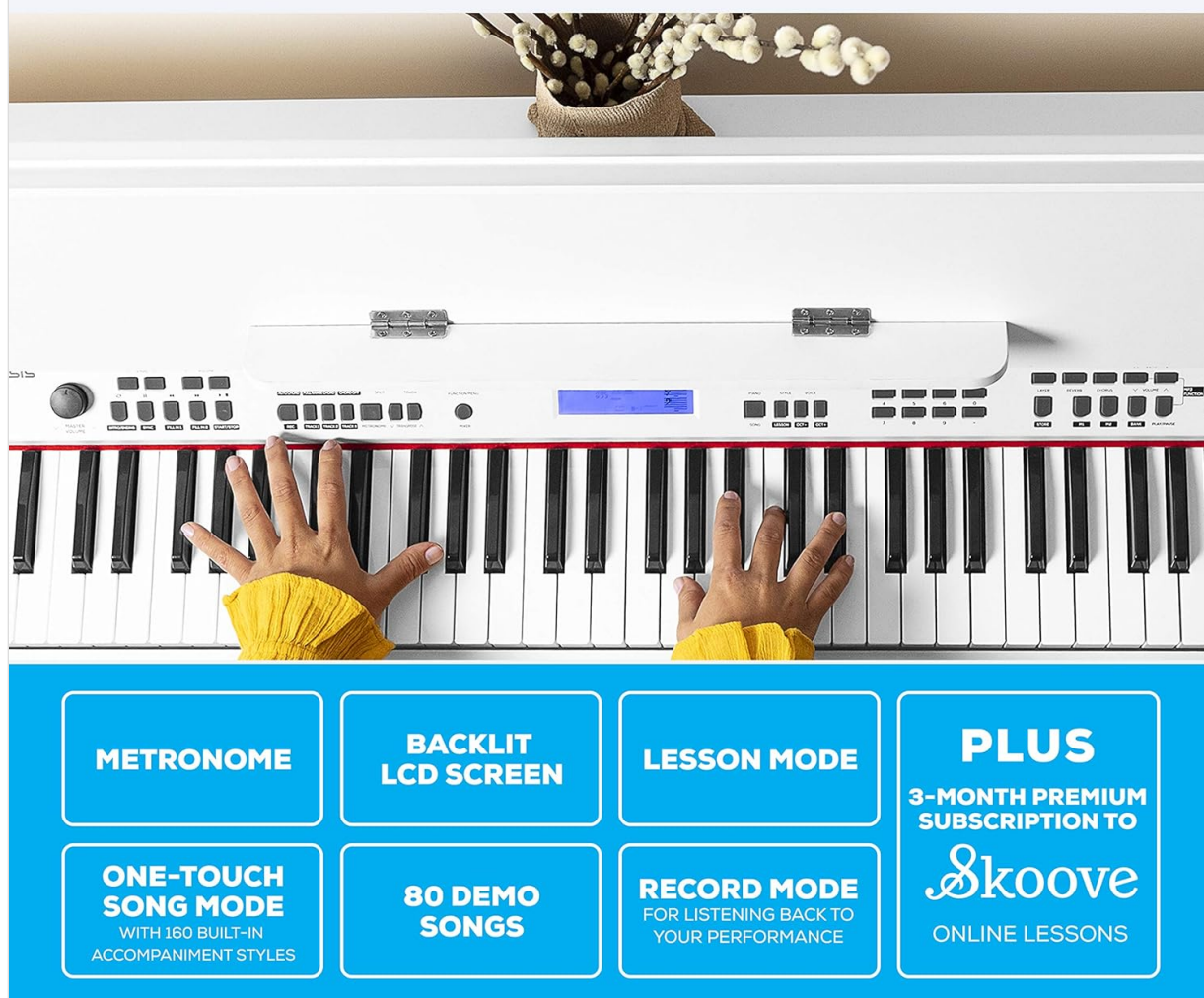

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Alesis Virtue AHP-1W Digital Piano, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the surface of the piano. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by a dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, solvents, or waxes.
- **Environment:** Keep the instrument away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and excessive humidity or dust. Extreme temperature changes can affect performance.
- **Transportation:** When moving the piano, ensure it is powered off and all cables are disconnected. Handle with care to prevent damage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Alesis Virtue AHP-1W, consult the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Sound:**

- Ensure the power adapter is securely connected and the piano is turned on.
- Check the Master Volume knob and increase the volume.
- If headphones are connected, disconnect them to check speaker output.
- Verify that the correct voice is selected and not set to a silent patch.

- **Keys Not Responding:**

- Ensure the instrument is powered on.
- Check if any mode (e.g., Lesson Mode) is active that might affect key response.

- **Distorted Sound:**

- Lower the Master Volume.
- If connected to external audio equipment, check their volume levels and connections.
