#### 1. Introduction

This instruction manual provides essential information for the proper use and activation of your T-Mobile Universal Triple-Cut SIM Card Kit. This kit includes two authentic T-Mobile SIM cards designed to connect your compatible device to the T-Mobile network for talk, text, and data services.

The SIM cards are engineered with a "triple-cut" design, allowing them to be adjusted to standard, micro, or nano SIM sizes, ensuring compatibility with a wide range of mobile phones and tablets, including older and newer models. These SIM cards utilize GSM technology and are compatible with 3G, 4G, and 4G LTE devices.

## 2. SETUP AND ACTIVATION

Before using your T-Mobile SIM card, it must be properly sized for your device and activated with T-Mobile service.

## 2.1 Sizing the SIM Card (Triple-Cut Design)

Your T-Mobile SIM card features a "triple-cut" design, meaning it can be adapted to three different sizes: Standard, Micro, and Nano. Identify the correct SIM card size required by your device before proceeding.

- 1. **Determine Required Size:** Consult your device's manual or check the existing SIM card slot to identify whether your device uses a Standard, Micro, or Nano SIM.
- 2. **Punch Out Correct Size:** Carefully punch out the SIM card from its larger frame to match the required size. Apply gentle, even pressure to avoid damaging the SIM card's contacts.
- 3. **Insert SIM Card:** With the device powered off, insert the correctly sized SIM card into the designated SIM card slot. Ensure it is oriented correctly according to your device's instructions.

## 2.2 Activating Your SIM Card

These SIM cards are unactivated upon purchase and require activation with T-Mobile. As of July 1st, 2020, these cards are primarily compatible with postpaid cellular service. Contact T-Mobile customer service to activate your SIM card and select a suitable service plan.

- Contact T-Mobile: Call T-Mobile customer service or visit their official website for activation. You may find contact information on the SIM card packaging or T-Mobile's official website.
- **Provide Information:** Be prepared to provide the following details to the T-Mobile representative:
  - The **IMEI number** of the device you intend to use the SIM card with. This can usually be found in your device's settings (e.g., About Phone) or by dialing \*#06#.
  - The SIM Card Number (ICCID) printed on the SIM card itself.
  - The **zip code** where the service will primarily be used.
- **Select Service Plan:** Discuss available postpaid service plans with the T-Mobile representative and choose one that fits your needs.
- Activation Fee: Be aware that T-Mobile may charge an activation fee (e.g., \$5) along with the first month's payment for your chosen data plan.




Image 2.2: An example of T-Mobile SIM Starter Kit information, indicating potential activation costs or retail pricing for the SIM card itself.

## 3. OPERATING YOUR SIM CARD

Once activated, your T-Mobile SIM card enables various cellular services on your compatible device.

- Talk: Make and receive phone calls using your assigned T-Mobile number.
- Text: Send and receive SMS (Short Message Service) and MMS (Multimedia Messaging Service) messages.
- Data: Access the internet via T-Mobile's 3G, 4G, or 4G LTE network, depending on your device's capabilities and network availability.
- Hotspot: If your service plan includes hotspot functionality, you can share your device's cellular data connection with other Wi-Fi enabled devices. Refer to your device's settings for hotspot setup instructions.

#### 4. MAINTENANCE

SIM cards are durable but require minimal care to ensure longevity and proper function.

- Handle with Care: Avoid bending or creasing the SIM card, as this can damage the internal chip or contacts.
- **Keep Dry:** Protect the SIM card from moisture and liquids. If it gets wet, allow it to dry completely before reinserting it into a device.
- Clean Contacts: If necessary, gently wipe the gold-colored contacts on the SIM card with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Avoid using abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.
- Store Safely: When not in use, store the SIM card in its original plastic frame or a protective case to prevent loss or damage.

#### 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your T-Mobile SIM card, consider the following troubleshooting steps:

## • SIM Not Recognized:

- Ensure the SIM card is correctly inserted into the SIM slot and fully seated.
- Restart your device.
- Verify that the SIM card is the correct size for your device.
- Check if the SIM card's gold contacts are clean and free of debris.

#### • No Network Signal / Limited Service:

- o Confirm that your SIM card has been successfully activated by T-Mobile.
- Check T-Mobile's network coverage in your current location.
- Ensure your device's cellular data is enabled in settings.
- Try toggling Airplane Mode on and off.

#### · Activation Issues:

- o Double-check that you provided the correct IMEI and SIM card number to T-Mobile during activation.
- Confirm that your device is unlocked and compatible with the T-Mobile GSM network.
- Contact T-Mobile customer service again to verify activation status and troubleshoot further.

If problems persist after attempting these steps, please contact T-Mobile customer support for further assistance.
