Installing Your Battery


1. Identify the battery compartment in your device.

3. Insert the Duracell 123 battery, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the device's markings.
4. Close the battery compartment securely.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

General Usage

Once installed, your device should power on. Always refer to your device's instruction manual for specific operating procedures.

- Always replace all batteries in a device at the same time.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.
- Remove batteries from devices that will not be used for extended periods to prevent potential leakage.

Care and Storage

- Keep batteries in a cool, dry place at room temperature.
- Do not store batteries loose in a pocket or purse to prevent short-circuiting.

Disposal

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues

- **Device not powering on:**
 - Check battery polarity to ensure correct insertion.
 - Ensure batteries are new and correctly installed.
 - Verify the device's battery contacts are clean and free of corrosion.
 - Replace with a fresh set of batteries.
- **Short battery life:**
 - Ensure the device is compatible with 3V Lithium batteries.
 - Check for any device malfunctions that might cause excessive power drain.
