4. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and follow these safety precautions to prevent injury or damage:

- Always handle hot water and coffee with care to avoid burns.
- Ensure the dripper is placed securely on a stable mug or carafe before pouring hot water.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not use the dripper for purposes other than brewing coffee.
- Inspect the dripper for any damage before each use. Do not use if damaged.

5. SETUP

Setting up your Gevi Pour Over Coffee Dripper is simple:

1. Unpack all components from the packaging.
2. Wash the stainless steel dripper and stand with warm soapy water, then rinse thoroughly and dry.
3. Place the dripper stand securely on top of your chosen coffee mug or carafe.
4. Insert the stainless steel cone filter into the stand.



6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to brew a perfect cup of pour-over coffee:

1. **Prepare Coffee Grounds:** Grind your favorite coffee beans to a medium-fine consistency, similar to table salt. For best results, use freshly ground coffee.
2. **Add Grounds:** Place the desired amount of coffee grounds into the stainless steel filter. A common ratio is 1:15 (1 gram of coffee to 15 ml of water), but adjust to your preference.
3. **Heat Water:** Heat fresh water to approximately 195-205°F (90-96°C). Do not use boiling water directly.
4. **Bloom:** Slowly pour a small amount of hot water (about twice the weight of the coffee grounds) evenly over the grounds, just enough to saturate them. Let it sit for 30-45 seconds. This allows the coffee to "bloom" and release gases.
5. **Pour:** Continue pouring the remaining hot water slowly and steadily in a circular motion, starting from the center and moving outwards, then back to the center. Avoid pouring directly onto the filter walls. Maintain a consistent pour rate.
6. **Brew:** Allow the coffee to drip completely into your mug or carafe. The total brewing time should typically be between 2.5 to 4 minutes, depending on grind size and pour rate.
7. **Enjoy:** Remove the dripper and enjoy your freshly brewed coffee.

7. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning will ensure the longevity and performance of your dripper:

1. After each use, discard used coffee grounds.

2. Rinse the stainless steel filter and stand under warm running water.
3. Use the provided small cleaning brush to gently scrub away any remaining coffee particles from the mesh filter.
4. For a deeper clean, wash with mild dish soap and warm water.
5. Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue and allow to air dry, or dry with a clean cloth.
6. The stainless steel dripper is also dishwasher safe.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Coffee brews too slowly.	Coffee grounds are too fine, or filter is clogged.	Use a coarser grind. Clean the filter thoroughly to remove any blockages.
Coffee brews too quickly.	Coffee grounds are too coarse.	Use a finer grind.
Coffee tastes weak.	Not enough coffee grounds, water too cool, or grounds too coarse.	Increase coffee amount, use hotter water (195-205°F), or use a finer grind.
Coffee tastes bitter.	Water too hot, grounds too fine, or over-extraction.	Use slightly cooler water, a coarser grind, or reduce brewing time.
