1. Introduction

This appliance combines a classic aesthetic with modern functionality, designed to provide convenient refrigeration in compact spaces such as offices, bedrooms, dorm rooms, or cabins. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your new refrigerator.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

• Flammable refrigerant (R600a) is used in this appliance.

• To be repaired only by trained service personnel. Do not puncture refrigerant tubing.

- Before attempting to install or service this product, ensure all safety precautions are followed.
- Dispose of this product properly in accordance with federal and local regulations for flammable refrigerant.

Always ensure the refrigerator is placed on a stable, level surface and is not exposed to direct sunlight or heat sources. Maintain adequate ventilation around the unit.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Built-in Bottle Opener (requires attachment)
- Door Handle (requires attachment)
- 2 Glass Shelves
- 1 Ice Cube Tray

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

4.1 Placement

Place the refrigerator on a firm, level surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources. The space-saving flush back design allows for seamless placement against walls. Ensure there is adequate air circulation around the unit for optimal performance.

4.2 Leveling

Your refrigerator is equipped with adjustable leveling legs. Use a wrench to adjust the legs to ensure the unit is perfectly level. This helps in proper door closure and efficient operation.

4.3 Door Reversibility

The door of your Frigidaire compact fridge is reversible, offering flexible placement options. Refer to the detailed diagrams in the printed manual for instructions on how to reverse the door swing.

4.4 Attaching Bottle Opener and Handle

The built-in bottle opener and chrome door handle are typically attached using screws. Align the components with the pre-drilled holes on the side and front of the refrigerator door, respectively, and secure them firmly.

4.5 Initial Cleaning and Power Connection

Before first use, clean the interior and exterior of the refrigerator with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Allow it to dry completely. Plug the unit into a dedicated 120 Volt electrical outlet. Allow the refrigerator to stand upright for at least 2-4 hours before plugging it in to allow the refrigerant to settle.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Temperature Control

The refrigerator features an adjustable temperature control dial located inside the unit, typically near the chiller compartment. Turn the dial to your desired setting. Lower numbers indicate warmer temperatures, while higher numbers indicate colder temperatures. Adjust as needed based on ambient temperature and contents.

5.2 Chiller Compartment

The integrated chiller compartment is designed for short-term storage of items requiring colder temperatures, such as ice cubes (using the provided tray) or small frozen items. Note that this is a chiller, not a full freezer, and may require manual defrosting periodically.

5.3 Organized Storage

The interior is designed for efficient organization:

• Glass Shelves: Two adjustable and removable glass shelves provide flexible storage for various

items.

- 2L Door Basket: A dedicated basket on the door accommodates larger bottles.
- Built-in Can Dispenser: Conveniently store and dispense standard-sized beverage cans.

5.4 LED Lighting

The interior LED light illuminates when the door is opened, providing clear visibility of the contents.

5.5 Quiet Operation

The refrigerator is designed for quiet operation, making it suitable for noise-sensitive environments like bedrooms or offices.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

6.1 Defrosting

The main refrigerator compartment features automatic defrost. The chiller compartment, however, requires manual defrosting when ice buildup becomes excessive (approximately 1/4 inch thick). To defrost the chiller, remove all contents, turn off the unit, and leave the chiller door open. Place a towel or shallow pan

to catch melting ice. Do not use sharp objects to remove ice.

6.2 Cleaning

Regularly clean the interior and exterior surfaces with a mild detergent and warm water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals. The glass shelves are removable for easy cleaning. Ensure the door gasket is clean and free of debris to maintain a proper seal.

6.3 Power Outages

In case of a power outage, keep the refrigerator door closed to maintain internal temperature for as long as possible. Avoid opening the door unnecessarily.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If your refrigerator is not operating correctly, consult the following common issues before contacting service:

- **Refrigerator does not operate:** Check if the power cord is securely plugged into the outlet. Verify the circuit breaker or fuse is not tripped. Ensure the temperature control is not set to 'OFF'.
- **Temperature is too warm:** Adjust the temperature control to a colder setting. Ensure the door is closing completely and not being opened too frequently. Check for proper ventilation around the unit.
- Excessive noise: Ensure the refrigerator is level. Check if any objects are vibrating against the unit. Normal operating sounds include a slight hum from the compressor and occasional gurgling from refrigerant flow.
- **Door does not close properly:** Check if the refrigerator is level. Ensure the door gasket is clean and free from obstructions. Avoid overfilling the refrigerator, which can prevent the door from sealing.

For issues not resolved by these steps, refer to the full owner's manual or contact Frigidaire customer support.
