## INSTRUCTION MANUAL

## SETUP

### Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure all parts listed in the manual are present. Dispose of packaging materials responsibly.

### Assembly

The blower requires minimal assembly. Attach the blower tube to the main unit as shown in the video below.

1. Align the blower tube with the air outlet on the main unit.
  2. Push the tube firmly onto the unit until it clicks into place or is securely seated.
  3. Ensure the tube is locked and cannot be easily pulled off.


## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Starting the Blower

1. Ensure the blower tube is securely attached.
2. Connect the power cord to a suitable 230V power outlet.
3. Press the ON/OFF switch to start the blower.

### Using the Blower

Hold the blower firmly and direct the air stream towards the debris you wish to clear. Use a sweeping motion to gather leaves and other light garden waste into piles for easy collection.

## Tips for Effective Use

- Work with the wind direction to maximize efficiency.
- Start blowing from the outer edges of the area and work inwards.
- Avoid blowing debris towards areas where it might cause a nuisance.

## MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your blower.

1. **Disconnect Power:** Always unplug the blower from the power source before cleaning.
2. **Clean Exterior:** Wipe the exterior surfaces with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
3. **Clear Air Vents:** Ensure the air intake and exhaust vents are free from debris. Use a soft brush or compressed air if necessary.
4. **Inspect Cord:** Regularly check the power cord for any signs of damage.

## Storage

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the table below for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Blower does not start	No power supply	Check if the power cord is securely plugged in and the outlet is functional.
Reduced air flow	Blocked air intake/outlet	Disconnect power and clear any debris from the air vents and blower tube.
Unusual noise/vibration	Debris inside the unit	Disconnect power and inspect for foreign objects. If problem persists, contact customer support.
