## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Fujitsu LIFEBOOK A573/G laptop. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize the lifespan of your device.

## SETUP

---

### 1. Connecting Power

1. Connect the AC adapter to the power input port on the laptop.
2. Plug the AC adapter into a wall outlet.
3. The laptop is ready for use. It is recommended to fully charge the battery before first use, though it is a used item and battery performance may vary.

## 2. Initial Boot-up

- Press the power button to turn on the laptop.
- The pre-installed Windows 10 Professional 64-bit operating system will start.
- Follow any on-screen prompts for initial setup if presented.

## 3. Connecting Peripherals

Your LIFEBOOK A573/G is equipped with various ports for connecting external devices.

- **USB Ports:** Connect USB devices such as mice, keyboards, or external storage drives to the available USB 2.0 (x2) or USB 3.0 (x2) ports.
- **LAN Port:** For wired network connection, connect an Ethernet cable to the LAN port.
- **HDMI Port:** Connect an external display or projector using an HDMI cable.
- **Analog Video Output:** For older displays, use the analog video output.
- **PC Card Slot:** Insert compatible PC Cards for expanded functionality.
- **Audio Jacks:** Connect headphones or an external microphone to the respective audio jacks.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 1. Using the Keyboard and Touchpad

The laptop features a standard keyboard and a touchpad for navigation. Please note that due to the used nature of this product, the keyboard may show signs of wear, including shine on keys and yellowing of characters. The flat pointer (touchpad) may also exhibit signs of use.

## 2. Using the DVD-ROM Drive

The integrated DVD-ROM drive supports reading of CD and DVD media. To use, gently press the eject button on the drive to open the tray, place the disc, and close the tray. The operating system will typically recognize the disc automatically.

## 3. Connecting to Wireless LAN (Wi-Fi)

Your laptop has built-in wireless LAN capabilities. To connect to a Wi-Fi network:

1. Click the Wi-Fi icon in the system tray (bottom right corner of the screen).
2. Select your desired network from the list of available networks.
3. Enter the network security key (password) if prompted.
4. Click "Connect".

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

---

Proper care helps maintain your laptop's performance and appearance. As this is a used product, please be aware of the following existing conditions:

- **Keyboard:** May have shine due to wear and yellowing on key characters.
- **Top Panel:** May have scratches.
- **Flat Pointer (Touchpad):** May show signs of use.
- **Screen:** May have scratches, white spots, black spots, or bright spots.
- **General Casing:** Minor rust on metal parts, scuffs/shine on casing surfaces, faded characters, small scratches, discoloration from sun exposure, and potentially missing rubber feet may be present.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

This section provides solutions to common issues you might encounter.

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
---------	---------------------------

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Laptop does not power on.	Ensure the AC adapter is securely connected to both the laptop and a working power outlet. Check if the power outlet is functional.
No display on screen.	Check if the laptop is powered on. Try connecting an external monitor to verify if the issue is with the laptop's internal display. (Note: Screen may have existing scratches/spots as described in Maintenance).
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi.	Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled in Windows settings. Verify the Wi-Fi password. Restart your router and the laptop.
DVD-ROM drive not reading discs.	Ensure the disc is clean and inserted correctly. Try a different disc.
USB devices not recognized.	Try a different USB port. Ensure the device drivers are installed (Windows 10 typically installs them automatically).

*Note:* The laptop has undergone operational tests for screen display, key input, USB port connection, network connection, wireless LAN connection, DVD playback, flat pointer, and speaker functionality. If issues persist, please refer to the support information.
