- Play/Pause Music: Press the button once.
- Skip to Next Track: Press the button twice quickly.
- Go to Previous Track: Press the button three times quickly.
- Answer/End Call: Press the button once during an incoming call or an active call.
- Reject Call: Press and hold the button during an incoming call.

Microphone Functionality

The integrated microphone has a frequency response of 100 Hz to 10,000 Hz and a sensitivity of 44 dBV/Pa, ensuring clear voice capture for calls and recordings.

MAINTENANCE

Troubleshooting
