SONGMICS 3M Round Garden Trampoline User Manual

Model: STR10BK

1. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

Thank you for choosing the SONGMICS 3-meter (10 ft) Round Garden Trampoline. This product is designed to provide a fun and active outdoor experience. This manual contains important information regarding the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your trampoline. Please read it thoroughly before assembly and retain it for future reference.

The trampoline features a dense inner safety net for enhanced shock resistance, reducing the chance of contact with the outer poles. The arched poles are covered with polyethylene foam for additional safety. This product has undergone TÜV Rheinland safety testing to ensure compliance with safety standards.

2. SAFETY GUIDELINES

Your safety is paramount. Adhere to the following guidelines to prevent injury and ensure safe use of the trampoline:

- **One User at a Time:** The trampoline must be used by only one person at a time. Multiple users simultaneously can lead to collisions and serious injury.
- **No Somersaults:** Do not attempt somersaults or flips on the trampoline. Improper landing can cause severe head, neck, or back injuries.
- **Do Not Hang:** Do not hang on the top bar or any part of the safety net structure. This can damage the net and cause falls.
- **Clear the Area:** Before jumping, ensure all sharp objects, jewelry, or loose clothing are removed from yourself and the trampoline area.
- **Age Restriction:** Not suitable for children under 3 years of age. Adult supervision is required for all users, especially children.
- **Domestic Use Only:** This trampoline is intended for domestic, private use only. It is not suitable for commercial or public use.
- **Proper Placement:** Place the trampoline on a level surface, away from obstacles such as fences, trees, power lines, or other structures. Ensure adequate overhead clearance.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all components are present before beginning assembly:

- 1 x 3-meter (10 ft) Trampoline Frame
- 1 x Jumping Mat
- 1 x Safety Net Enclosure
- 1 x Ladder
- 1 x Safety Pad (Spring Cover)
- 1 x Accessory Kit (includes springs, tools, and fasteners)
- 1 x Instruction Manual

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly requires at least two adults. Follow the instructions provided in the included manual carefully.

Below are general steps:

1. **Unpack Components:** Lay out all parts on a clean, flat surface and identify them using the parts list in your manual.
2. **Assemble the Frame:** Connect the frame sections to form the circular base. Ensure all connections are secure.
3. **Attach the Jumping Mat:** Carefully attach the springs to the jumping mat and the frame. Use the provided spring tool for easier and safer installation. Ensure even tension.
4. **Install Safety Pad:** Place the safety pad over the springs and frame, ensuring it covers all exposed metal parts and springs.
5. **Install Safety Net Poles:** Attach the arched safety net poles to the trampoline frame. Ensure they are securely fastened. These poles are covered with polyethylene foam for safety.
6. **Install Safety Net:** Secure the safety net to the poles and the jumping mat. Ensure the zipper entrance is functional and closes properly.
7. **Attach Ladder:** Assemble and attach the ladder to the trampoline frame for safe entry and exit.




Image: Assembly of the safety net pole, showing the curved design and connection points to the trampoline frame. Close-ups illustrate securing the pole with a screw.





Image: Detailed view of the trampoline springs, demonstrating their robust construction and connection to the jumping mat and frame.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled, ensure the trampoline is stable and all safety features are correctly in place before use.

- **Entry and Exit:** Always use the provided ladder for safe entry and exit. Open and close the safety net zipper carefully.
- **Supervision:** Children must always be supervised by a responsible adult while using the trampoline.
- **Controlled Jumping:** Encourage users to jump in the center of the mat and maintain control. Avoid erratic or uncontrolled bouncing.
- **Weather Conditions:** Do not use the trampoline in strong winds, rain, or other adverse weather

conditions. High winds can lift the trampoline.

6. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your trampoline and ensure continued safety.

- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check all nuts, bolts, and connections for tightness. Ensure springs are securely attached and not damaged. Inspect the jumping mat, safety net, and safety pad for tears, holes, or deterioration.
- **Cleaning:** Clean the jumping mat and safety pad with mild soap and water. Avoid harsh chemicals that could damage the materials.
- **Weather Protection:** During prolonged periods of non-use or severe weather, consider disassembling and storing the trampoline indoors, or using a weather cover to protect it from elements.
- **Rust Prevention:** The frame is made of galvanized steel, but regular inspection for rust and applying rust-preventative coatings can prolong its life.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your trampoline, consider the following common solutions:

- **Loose Frame/Wobbling:** Check all frame connections and leg attachments. Ensure bolts are tightened according to the assembly instructions.

- **Uneven Jumping Mat Tension:** Verify that all springs are correctly installed and evenly distributed around the frame. Replace any stretched or damaged springs.
- **Damaged Safety Net/Pad:** Inspect for tears or holes. Damaged safety components should be replaced immediately to maintain safety.
- **Squeaking Noises:** Apply a silicone-based lubricant to spring connections or frame joints if persistent squeaking occurs.
