1. INTRODUCTION

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these general steps to install your HP 910 Black Ink Cartridge. Refer to your printer's specific user manual for detailed instructions and illustrations.

1. **Power On:** Ensure your HP printer is powered on.
2. **Open Access Door:** Open the ink cartridge access door on your printer. The print carriage will move to the access area. Wait until it is stationary before proceeding.
3. **Remove Old Cartridge (if applicable):** Gently press down on the old cartridge to release it, then pull it out of its slot.
4. **Unpack New Cartridge:** Remove the new HP 910 Black Ink Cartridge from its packaging.
5. **Remove Protective Tape:** Carefully remove the orange pull tab and protective tape from the cartridge. **Do not touch the copper-colored contacts or ink nozzles.**
6. **Insert Cartridge:** Hold the cartridge with the HP logo facing up and slide it into the correct black ink slot until it clicks into place.
7. **Close Access Door:** Close the ink cartridge access door. The printer may perform an alignment process.

4. OPERATING AND PRINTING TIPS

To achieve optimal print quality and cartridge longevity, consider the following:

- **Use Genuine HP Ink:** Original HP ink cartridges are designed to work seamlessly with HP printers for consistent results.
- **Print Regularly:** Printing at least once a week helps prevent ink nozzles from drying out.

- **Check Ink Levels:** Monitor ink levels through your printer software to avoid running out during important print jobs.
- **Page Yield:** The HP 910 Black Ink Cartridge yields approximately 300 pages, based on ISO/IEC 24711 or HP testing methodology. Actual yield varies considerably based on content of printed pages and other factors.

5. MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

Proper handling and storage can extend the life of your ink cartridges and maintain print quality.

- **Storage:** Store new, unopened cartridges in their original sealed packaging at room temperature, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Handling:** Avoid touching the electrical contacts or print nozzles on the cartridge to prevent clogs, ink failure, and poor electrical connection.
- **Installation Timing:** Install cartridges immediately after removing them from their packaging.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

If you encounter printing problems, consider the following general troubleshooting steps:

- **Poor Print Quality:** If prints are faded, streaky, or missing colors, try running the printhead cleaning utility from your printer's software or control panel.
- **Cartridge Not Recognized:** Ensure the cartridge is correctly seated in its slot. Remove and reinsert it. Clean the electrical contacts on the cartridge and in the printer with a lint-free cloth if necessary.
- **Low Ink Warning:** Replace the cartridge when prompted by your printer or when print quality degrades.

- **Printer Firmware:** Keep your printer's firmware updated to ensure optimal performance and compatibility with genuine HP cartridges.
