# Trexonic 14.1" Portable DVD Player

USER MANUAL - MODEL: 14.1" PORTABLE DVD PLAYER

### Introduction

Welcome to the user manual for your new Trexonic 14.1" Portable DVD Player. This device is designed to provide portable entertainment with its large TFT-LCD screen, versatile media playback options (DVD, USB, SD), and long-lasting rechargeable battery. This manual will guide you through the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your player to ensure you get the most out of your device.

## Product Overview

---

The Trexonic 14.1" Portable DVD Player features a high-resolution TFT-LCD screen that swivels 270° and tilts 180°, allowing for optimal viewing angles. It supports various media formats from DVDs, USB drives, and SD cards. The player includes a rechargeable battery for extended use on the go and comes with a car adaptor for in-vehicle charging.

### Key Features:

- 14.1" TFT-LCD Swivel Screen (270° swivel, 180° tilt)
- Supports DVD, CD, USB, and SD card playback
- Built-in rechargeable battery
- Multiple input/output ports: USB, SD, Earphones, AV Input, AV Output, DC Input

## Setup

---

### 1. Initial Charging:

Before first use, fully charge the player's internal battery. Connect the provided AC power adapter to the DC Input port on the player and plug it into a standard wall outlet. The charging indicator light will typically show red while charging and turn green when fully charged. A full charge may take several hours.

### 2. Powering On:

Press and hold the **POWER** button on the player or the remote control to turn the unit on.

### 3. Inserting Media:

- **DVD/CD:** Gently open the disc cover and place the disc onto the spindle with the label side facing up. Close the disc cover securely.
- **USB Drive:** Insert your USB flash drive into the USB port.
- **SD Card:** Insert your SD card into the SD card slot until it clicks into place.

## Operating Instructions

---

### 1. Basic Playback:

Once media is inserted, the player will typically auto-detect and begin playback. If not, use the **MODE** button on the player or remote to select the desired input source (DVD, USB, SD).

### 2. Screen Adjustment:

The screen can be swiveled up to 270° and tilted up to 180° for optimal viewing. Carefully rotate the screen from its base to achieve the desired angle. The screen can also be folded flat against the player with the screen facing outwards.

### 3. Using Controls:

- **Play/Pause:** Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** button to start or pause playback.
- **Stop:** Press the **STOP** button to stop playback.

- **Next/Previous:** Use the **NEXT** and **PREV** buttons to skip tracks/chapters.
- **Fast Forward/Rewind:** Hold the **FWD** or **REV** buttons for fast forward or rewind.
- **Volume:** Use the **VOL+** and **VOL-** buttons to adjust the volume.
- **Setup:** Press the **SETUP** button to access system settings.

#### 4. Connecting to External Devices:

- **AV Output:** Connect the player to a TV or larger display using an AV cable (not included) from the AV OUT port.
- **AV Input:** Connect external video sources (e.g., game console) to the AV IN port to display them on the player's screen.
- **Earphones:** Plug standard 3.5mm headphones into the Earphones jack for private listening.

## Maintenance

---

### 1. Cleaning the Screen:

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the screen. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaning solution. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

### 2. Cleaning the Disc Tray:

Keep the disc tray free of dust and debris. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the area. Do not use liquids inside the disc compartment.

### 3. Battery Care:

To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. If storing the player for an extended period, charge the battery to about 50% and store in a cool, dry place.

### 4. Storage:

When not in use, store the player in a clean, dry environment away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and excessive humidity.

## Troubleshooting

---

If you encounter issues with your Trexonic Portable DVD Player, refer to the following common problems and their solutions:

- **No Power:**
  - Ensure the AC adapter is securely connected to the player and a working power outlet.
  - Check if the battery is charged. If not, charge the unit for a few hours.
  - Press and hold the POWER button for a few seconds.
- **No Disc Playback:**
  - Ensure the disc is clean and free of scratches.
  - Verify the disc is inserted correctly with the label side facing up.
  - Check if the disc format is supported by the player.
  - Select the correct input mode (DVD) using the MODE button.
- **No Sound/Picture:**
  - Adjust the volume level.

- If using external speakers or TV, ensure connections are secure and the external device is set to the correct input.
- Check if headphones are plugged in, which may mute the internal speakers.
- **Remote Control Not Working:**
  - Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the player's IR sensor.
  - Replace the batteries in the remote control.
