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1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Constructed from E1 Particle Board, this unit features secure side and back panels to prevent items from falling and an enlarged base for enhanced stability.

2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

This bookcase requires assembly. Please follow these instructions carefully to ensure proper construction and stability. It is recommended to have a clear, spacious area for assembly.

2.1. Package Contents

Before starting, verify that all parts and hardware are present. Refer to the included parts list in your package. If any components are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

2.2. Assembly Steps

- 1. Prepare the Area:** Clear a flat, clean surface for assembly. It is advisable to place a soft cloth or cardboard down to prevent scratching the furniture parts or your floor.
- 2. Identify Components:** Unpack all components and sort them according to the labels (e.g., A, B, C for panels; 1, 2, 3 for screws). The structure is designed for straightforward assembly.
- 3. Assemble the Base:** Begin by attaching the side panels to the base plate. Ensure the enlarged base plate is correctly oriented for maximum stability.

4. **Construct the Vertical Structure:** Gradually connect the vertical and horizontal shelf panels, following the numerical or alphabetical order provided in your specific instruction diagram. The tree diagram design enhances stability.
5. **Install Back Panels:** Secure the back panels to the rear of the bookcase. These panels are crucial for reinforcement and preventing items from falling.
6. **Tighten All Fasteners:** Once all components are in place, carefully tighten all screws and fasteners. Avoid over-tightening to prevent damage to the E1 Particle Board.
7. **Wall Mount (Optional but Recommended):** For added safety, especially in homes with children or pets, utilize the provided wall-mounting hardware to secure the bookcase to a wall. This prevents tipping.

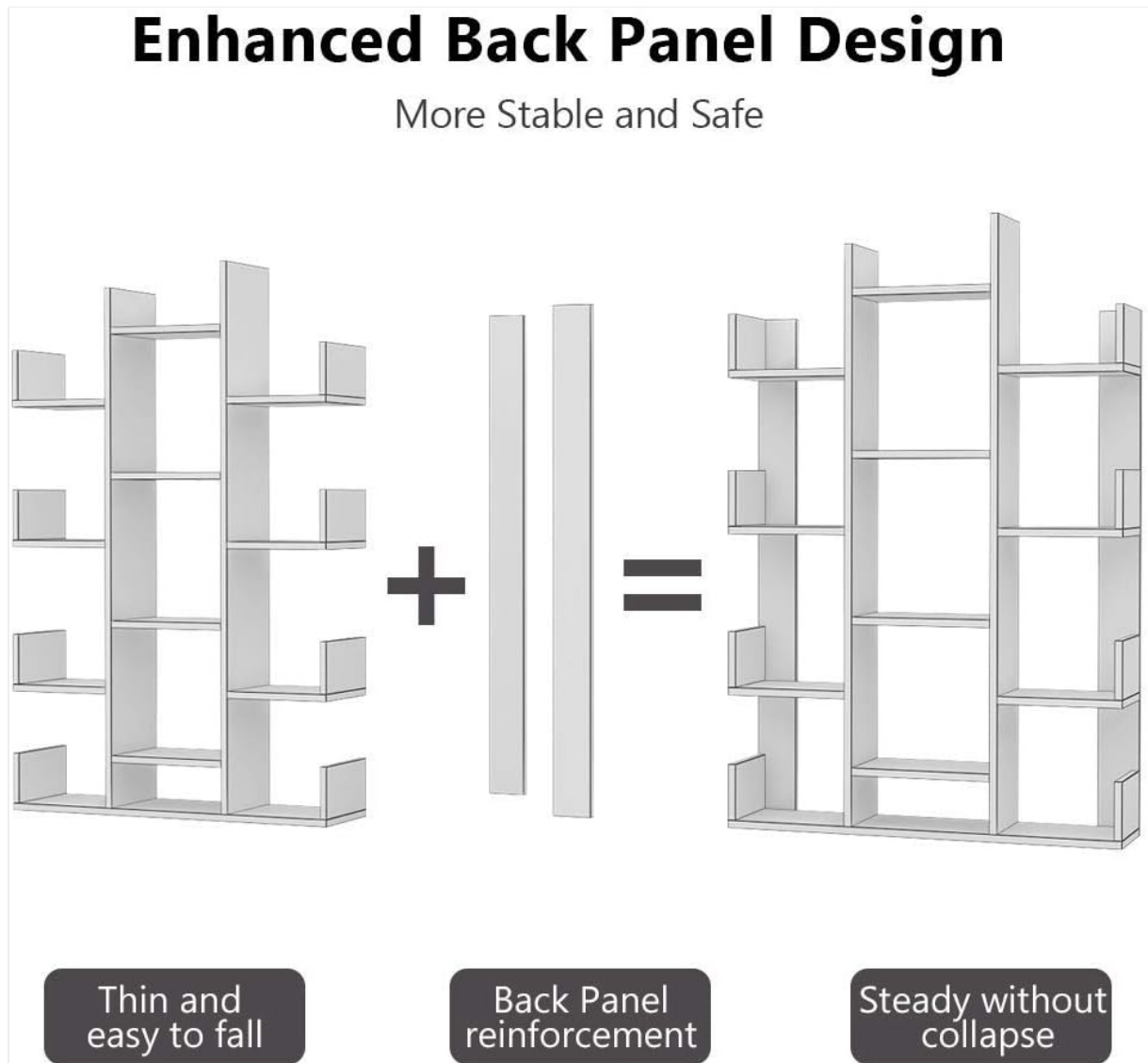


Image 2.1: Illustration of the enhanced back panel design, demonstrating how it contributes to the bookcase's stability and safety.

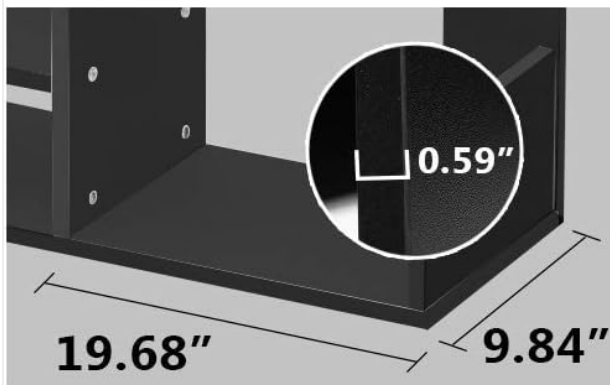

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Tribesigns 12-Shelf Tree Bookcase is designed for versatile use. Follow these guidelines for optimal performance and longevity.

3.1. Placement

- Place the bookcase on a flat, level surface to prevent wobbling and ensure stability.
- Avoid placing the unit in direct sunlight or near heat sources to prevent material degradation.
- This unit is suitable for living rooms, bedrooms, kids' rooms, dorms, and home offices.

3.2. Loading the Shelves

- Each shelf is designed to support up to 25 lbs (approximately 11.3 kg). Do not exceed this weight limit per shelf.
- Distribute weight evenly across the shelves to maintain balance and prevent strain on the structure.
- Utilize the 12 tiers for organizing books, magazines, CDs, records, photo frames, small plants, and decorative items.
- The side panels are designed to help prevent items from falling off the shelves.

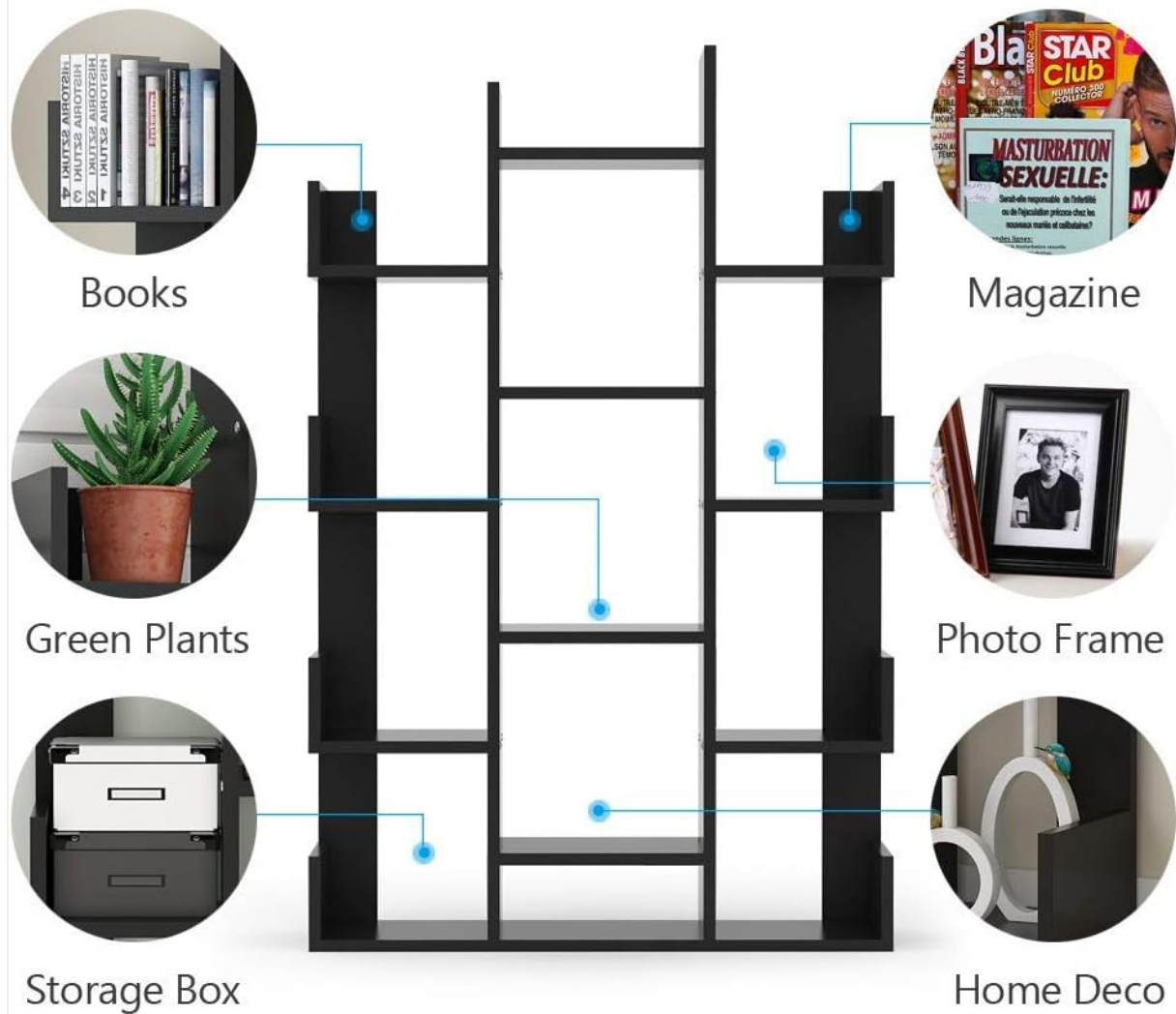


Image 3.1: Visual representation of the bookcase's capacity for various items such as books, plants, and decorative elements.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your Tribesigns bookcase.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the surface with a dry, soft cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or excessive moisture, as these can damage the E1 Particle Board finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten if necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Keep the bookcase in a stable indoor environment. Extreme temperature changes or high humidity can affect the material.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bookcase, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bookcase is wobbly or unstable.	Uneven floor surface; loose fasteners; incorrect assembly.	Ensure the bookcase is on a level surface. Check and tighten all screws. Review assembly steps to confirm correct installation. Utilize wall-mounting hardware if not already done.
Parts do not align during assembly.	Incorrect orientation of parts; manufacturing tolerance.	Double-check the part labels and orientation against the assembly diagram. Sometimes, slight adjustments or loosening adjacent screws can help align parts before re-tightening.
Screws do not tighten properly.	Stripped screw hole; incorrect screw type used.	Ensure you are using the correct screw for each hole. If a hole is stripped, contact customer support for replacement parts or advice. Avoid over-tightening.
Items falling off shelves.	Overloaded shelves; items placed too close to edge; missing side panels.	Do not exceed the 25 lbs weight limit per shelf. Ensure items are placed securely within the shelf boundaries. Verify all side panels are correctly installed.

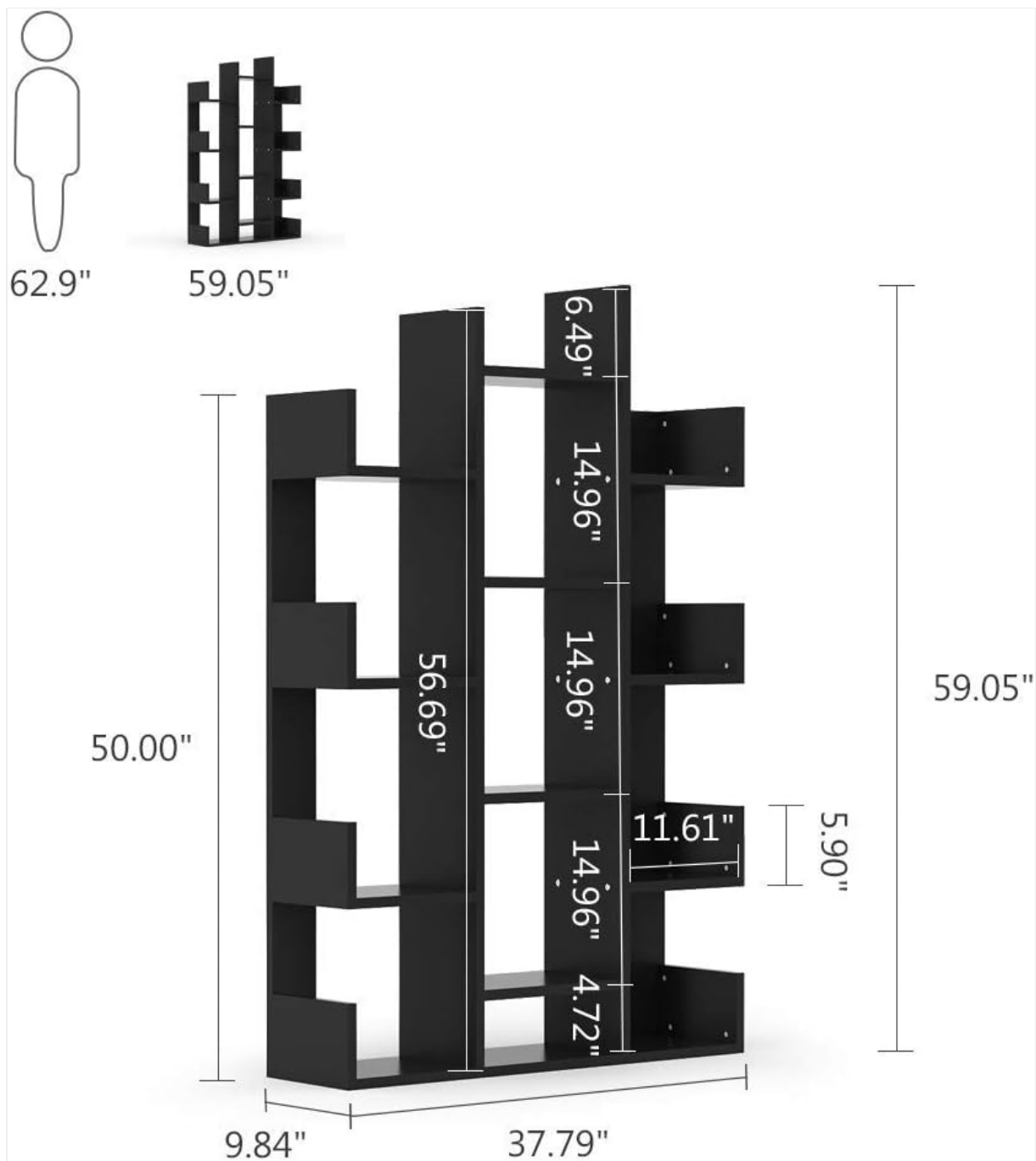


Image 6.1: Detailed dimensional drawing of the bookcase, including overall and individual shelf measurements.
