SteamOne Dualys Plus Garment Steamer Instruction Manual

Model: DP80SB

1. INTRODUCTION

The SteamOne Dualys Plus (model DP80SB) is a high-performance garment steamer designed for efficient and gentle fabric care. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your device. Please read all instructions carefully before first use and retain this manual for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Keep the appliance out of reach of children and pets.
- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Use only distilled or demineralized water to prevent mineral buildup and ensure optimal performance.
- Never direct steam at people, animals, or electrical appliances. Steam is hot and can cause burns.
- Unplug the appliance from the power outlet when not in use, before filling or emptying the water tank, and before cleaning.
- Ensure the power cord is not damaged. Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- Place the appliance on a stable, flat surface during use.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended while it is operating.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your SteamOne Dualys Plus garment steamer.

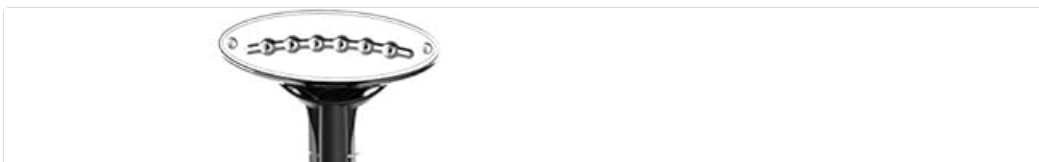






Image: Full view of the Dualys Plus steamer.

- **Base Unit:** Contains the double boiler, water tank, and control panel.
- **Water Tank:** Removable tank for filling with water.
- **Telescopic Pole:** Adjustable pole to support the steam head and hanger.
- **Steam Head:** Emits steam for wrinkle removal.
- **Hose:** Connects the steam head to the base unit.
- **Power Button/Control:** To turn the device on/off and adjust steam settings.

5. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.

2. **Assemble Pole:** Insert the telescopic pole into the designated slot on the base unit. Extend the pole to your desired height and secure it.
3. **Attach Hanger:** Place the garment hanger onto the top of the telescopic pole.
4. **Connect Steam Head:** Securely attach the steam head hose to the connection port on the base unit.
5. **Fill Water Tank:** Remove the water tank from the base unit. Fill it with distilled or demineralized water up to the maximum fill line. Reinsert the water tank firmly into the base unit.
6. **Position:** Place the steamer on a stable, level surface.
7. **Plug In:** Connect the power cord to a suitable electrical outlet.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Power On:** Press the power button on the base unit. The indicator light will illuminate.
2. **Heat Up:** Allow approximately 45 seconds for the steamer to heat up and produce steam.
3. **Prepare Garment:** Hang the garment on the provided hanger. For best results, gently pull the fabric taut with one hand while steaming with the other.
4. **Steam:** Hold the steam head a few centimeters away from the fabric. Move the steam head slowly over the garment, allowing the steam to penetrate the fibers and relax wrinkles. Use the fabric brush attachment for thicker fabrics or to remove lint.
5. **Adjust Steam (if applicable):** The Dualys Plus features 4 speed settings. Adjust the steam output as needed for different fabric types.
6. **Finish:** Once steaming is complete, press the power button to turn off the appliance.
7. **Cool Down:** Allow the steamer to cool completely before storing.

7. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Empty Water Tank:** After each use, always empty any remaining water from the tank to prevent stagnant water and mineral buildup.
- **Descaling:** Depending on water hardness and frequency of use, descaling may be required periodically. Refer to the manufacturer's website or contact customer support for specific descaling instructions.
- **Cleaning Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the appliance with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or

solvents.

- **Storage:** Store the steamer in a dry, cool place. Ensure the hose is not kinked during storage.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam production	Water tank is empty or not properly seated. Appliance not powered on.	Fill the water tank. Ensure the tank is correctly inserted. Press the power button.
Water leaking from steam head	Hose connection is loose. Water tank overfilled.	Check and tighten hose connections. Do not overfill the water tank.
Appliance not turning on	No power supply. Power cord damaged.	Check if the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Inspect the power cord for damage.
Steam output is weak	Mineral buildup (scaling). Water tank low.	Perform descaling procedure. Refill water tank.
