Apple iPhone XR User Manual

Model: iPhone XR (128GB, AT&T, Renewed)

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Apple iPhone XR. The iPhone XR features a 6.1-inch Liquid Retina LCD display, powered by Apple's A12 Bionic processor, offering robust performance and a high-quality camera. This renewed device has undergone a full diagnostic test to ensure like-new functionality and has a minimum battery capacity of 80%.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unboxing your Apple iPhone XR, you should find the following items:

- Apple iPhone XR device
- Generic (Mfi certified) charger
- Charging cable
- Documentation

Please note: Headphones and a SIM card are not included with this device.

SETUP GUIDE

1. Initial Power On

To power on your iPhone XR, press and hold the **Side button** (located on the right side of the device) until the Apple logo appears. Follow the on-screen instructions to select your language, region, and connect to a Wi-Fi network.

2. SIM Card Installation

Your iPhone XR requires a Nano-SIM card for cellular service. Locate the SIM tray on the right side of the

device. Use a SIM ejector tool (not included) or a small paperclip to open the tray. Insert your Nano-SIM card into the tray with the gold contacts facing down and the clipped corner aligned. Gently push the tray back into the device.

3. Face ID Setup

Face ID allows you to securely unlock your iPhone and authenticate purchases using facial recognition. During the initial setup, you will be prompted to set up Face ID. Follow the on-screen instructions to scan your face. Ensure you are in a well-lit area and hold the device at a comfortable distance from your face.

4. Network Connection

After initial setup, ensure your device is connected to a cellular network (AT&T for this model) or a Wi-Fi network. Go to **Settings > Wi-Fi** to connect to a Wi-Fi network, or verify cellular service is active.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Navigation

The iPhone XR uses intuitive gestures for navigation:

- **Home Screen:** Swipe up from the bottom edge of the screen.
- **App Switcher:** Swipe up from the bottom edge and pause in the middle of the screen.
- **Control Center:** Swipe down from the top-right corner of the screen.
- **Notifications:** Swipe down from the top-center of the screen.

2. Camera Usage

The iPhone XR features a 12 MP rear-facing camera capable of capturing high-quality photos and 4K video at 24, 30, or 60 frames per second. To open the camera, tap the **Camera app icon** on your home screen. Select different modes like Photo, Portrait, or Video by swiping across the screen. Tap the **shutter button** to capture an image or start/stop video recording.

3. App Management

Download new applications from the **App Store**. To organize apps, touch and hold an app icon until it jiggles, then drag it to a new location or into a folder. To delete an app, tap the 'X' icon that appears on the jiggling app.

4. Display Brightness

Adjust the screen brightness by swiping down from the top-right corner to open the Control Center. Drag the **Brightness slider** up or down. The iPhone XR's Liquid Retina HD display is designed to be extremely bright, allowing for clear visibility in various lighting conditions.

MAINTENANCE

1. Battery Care

To maximize battery life, avoid extreme temperatures. For this renewed device, the battery is guaranteed to have a minimum capacity of 80%. Regularly check **Settings > Battery > Battery Health** for information on your battery's performance.

2. Software Updates

Your iPhone XR will continue to receive the latest iOS updates, ensuring access to new features, security enhancements, and performance improvements. To check for updates, go to **Settings > General > Software Update**.

3. Cleaning Your Device

To clean your iPhone XR, use a soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid abrasive materials, aerosols, or cleaning sprays. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Do not submerge the device in water as it is not water resistant.

TROUBLESHOOTING

1. Device Freezing or Unresponsive

If your iPhone XR becomes unresponsive, perform a force restart:

1. Press and quickly release the **Volume Up button**.
2. Press and quickly release the **Volume Down button**.
3. Press and hold the **Side button** until the Apple logo appears.

2. Face ID Not Working

Ensure your face is fully visible to the TrueDepth camera and that nothing is obstructing it. If issues persist, try resetting Face ID in **Settings > Face ID & Passcode** and setting it up again.

3. Network Connectivity Issues

If you experience problems with Wi-Fi or cellular data, try toggling Airplane Mode on and off in the Control Center. You can also reset network settings by going to **Settings > General > Transfer or Reset iPhone > Reset > Reset Network Settings**.
