1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient use of your boAt Stone 650 Bluetooth Speaker. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The boAt Stone 650 is a portable Bluetooth speaker designed for immersive audio experiences. It features a robust design, integrated controls, and IPX5 water and dust resistance.

3.1 Controls and Ports

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to turn on/off.
- **Volume Up (+):** Increase volume.
- **Volume Down (-):** Decrease volume.
- **Play/Pause Button:** Play or pause audio.
- **Next Track Button:** Skip to the next song.
- **Previous Track Button:** Go to the previous song.
- **Mode Button (M):** Switch between Bluetooth and AUX modes.
- **Charging Port:** For connecting the charging cable.
- **AUX Input:** For wired audio connection.

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Speaker

Before first use, fully charge the speaker. Connect the provided charging cable to the speaker's charging port and a USB power adapter (not included). The LED indicator will show charging status.

Upto 7 Hours of Playback Time

4.2 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button until the LED indicator lights up and you hear an audible prompt.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until the LED indicator turns off and you hear an audible prompt.

4.3 Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the speaker is powered on and in Bluetooth pairing mode (LED indicator will flash).
2. On your device (smartphone, tablet, etc.), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
3. Select "boAt Stone 650" from the list of devices.
4. Once paired, the speaker will indicate a successful connection, and the LED will stop flashing.
5. If prompted for a password, enter "0000".

4.4 AUX Connectivity

To connect via AUX, plug one end of a 3.5mm audio cable (not included) into the speaker's AUX input and the other end into your audio device's headphone jack. The speaker will automatically switch to AUX mode or you may need to press the Mode button.

5. OPERATING THE SPEAKER

5.1 Playback Controls

- **Play/Pause:** Short press the Play/Pause button.
- **Volume Up:** Short press the "+" button.
- **Volume Down:** Short press the "-" button.
- **Next Track:** Long press the "Next Track" button.
- **Previous Track:** Long press the "Previous Track" button.

5.2 Call Management

When connected via Bluetooth, you can manage calls directly from the speaker:

- **Answer Call:** Short press the Play/Pause button.
- **End Call:** Short press the Play/Pause button during a call.
- **Reject Call:** Long press the Play/Pause button.

5.3 Water and Dust Resistance (IPX5)

The boAt Stone 650 is IPX5 rated, meaning it is protected against low-pressure water jets from any direction and is dust resistant. This makes it suitable for outdoor use and environments where it might be exposed to splashes or dust. Do not submerge the speaker in water.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the speaker. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the speaker in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the speaker frequently. Charge it regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Speaker does not turn on.	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a power source and try again.

Problem	Possible Solution
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	<p>Ensure the speaker is in pairing mode (flashing LED).</p> <p>Make sure your device's Bluetooth is enabled and within range.</p> <p>Forget "boAt Stone 650" from your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again.</p> <p>Restart both the speaker and your device.</p>
No sound or low volume.	<p>Increase volume on both the speaker and your connected device.</p> <p>Ensure the speaker is correctly paired or AUX cable is fully inserted.</p> <p>Check if the audio source is playing.</p>
Sound distortion.	<p>Reduce the volume on both the speaker and your device.</p> <p>Ensure the speaker is not too far from the Bluetooth source.</p> <p>Check for interference from other wireless devices.</p>
