SETUP GUIDE

- Your device should now be connected to the internet.

• Connecting Wired Devices:

• WPS (Wi-Fi Protected Setup):

If your device supports WPS, press the WPS button on your router and then activate WPS on your device within two
minutes to establish a secure connection without entering the password.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure optimal performance and longevity of your router:

- **Placement:** Place the router in a central location, away from obstructions and other electronic devices that may cause interference.
- Cleaning: Keep the router clean and free of dust. Use a soft, dry cloth for cleaning.
- **Firmware Updates:** Periodically check the Ematic support website for firmware updates. Updating the firmware can improve performance, add new features, and enhance security.
- Rebooting: If you experience slow speeds or connectivity issues, try rebooting the router by unplugging it from the
 power outlet for 10 seconds and then plugging it back in.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

No Internet Access:

- Check all cable connections between the modem and router.
- · Restart both your modem and router.
- Verify your internet service is active with your ISP.

• Weak Wi-Fi Signal:

- Relocate the router to a more central position in your home.
- Ensure antennas are properly oriented (typically upright).
- Minimize interference from other electronic devices (e.g., cordless phones, microwaves).

• Cannot Access Router's Web Interface:

- Ensure your device is connected to the router's Wi-Fi network or via an Ethernet cable.
- Double-check the IP address entered in the browser.
- · Clear your browser's cache or try a different browser.

• Forgot Wi-Fi Password or Login Credentials:

Perform a factory reset by pressing and holding the reset button on the router for about 10 seconds. Note: This will
erase all custom settings, and you will need to reconfigure the router.
