1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective installation, operation, and maintenance of your Philips Hue Econic Up Outdoor Smart Wall Light. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Risk of electric shock. Installation requires knowledge of electrical wiring systems. If not qualified, do not attempt installation. Contact a qualified electrician.

- Disconnect power at the circuit breaker before installation or servicing.
- Ensure all connections are secure and correct to prevent electrical hazards.
- This product is designed for outdoor use and is UL Wet Location rated.
- Do not modify the product in any way not described in this manual.
- Use only with Philips Hue E26 White and Color Ambiance LED bulbs.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

The package includes:

- 1x Philips Hue Eonic Up Outdoor Smart Wall Light fixture
- 1x E26 White and Color Ambiance LED Color-Changing Bulb
- Installation hardware (screws, wire nuts)
- User Manual

Note: A Philips Hue Bridge is required for smart features and is sold separately.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

4.1 Physical Installation

The Philips Hue Econic Up light fixture is designed for hard-wired wall mount installation. Follow these general steps:

1. **Turn off power:** Ensure electricity to the installation area is completely off at the circuit breaker.
2. **Prepare wiring:** Connect the fixture's wires to your household wiring according to local electrical codes. Typically, this involves connecting live, neutral, and ground wires.
3. **Mount the fixture:** Securely attach the light fixture to the wall using the provided hardware.
4. **Install bulb:** Screw the E26 Philips Hue bulb into the fixture.
5. **Restore power:** Turn the electricity back on at the circuit breaker.

4.2 Connecting to Philips Hue Bridge and App

To unlock smart features, your Econic Up light requires a Philips Hue Bridge (sold separately) and the Philips Hue App.

1. **Install Hue Bridge:** Connect your Philips Hue Bridge to your Wi-Fi router and power it on.
2. **Download App:** Download the Philips Hue App from your device's app store (www.philips-hue.com/app).
3. **Discover Lights:** Open the Hue App, navigate to Settings > Lights > Add Light, and follow the on-screen instructions to discover your new Econic Up light.

5. OPERATION

5.1 Color and Brightness Control

Using the Philips Hue App, you can select from 16 million colors and 50,000 shades of white light (warm to cool). Adjust brightness levels to suit your preference or activity.




Figure 4: The Philips Hue App allows selection of 16 million colors and various shades of white.

5.2 Voice Control

Integrate your Philips Hue system with voice assistants like Amazon Alexa, Google Assistant, or Apple HomeKit for hands-free control. Set up voice commands within the respective apps or the Hue App.




Figure 5: Voice control integration with Amazon Alexa and Google Assistant.

5.3 Automations and Scenes

Create custom scenes and automations through the Philips Hue App. This includes scheduling lights to turn on/off, setting routines based on time of day, or linking with Philips Hue Outdoor Motion Sensors for enhanced security and convenience.

6. MAINTENANCE

The Philips Hue Econic Up light is designed for durability and minimal maintenance.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically clean the exterior of the fixture with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Bulb Replacement:** If the LED bulb needs replacement, ensure power is off at the circuit breaker. Replace with a compatible Philips Hue E26 White and Color Ambiance LED bulb.
- **Weather Resistance:** The fixture is weatherproof (UL Wet Location rated). Ensure all seals and covers are properly secured after any maintenance to maintain water resistance.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Light does not turn on.	No power, loose wiring, faulty bulb.	Check circuit breaker. Verify wiring connections. Replace bulb.
Light not responding to app/voice control.	Hue Bridge not connected, light out of range, app issue.	Ensure Hue Bridge is powered and connected to router. Check light's proximity to Bridge. Restart Hue App.
Colors are incorrect or inconsistent.	Software glitch, bulb issue.	Restart the light by cycling power. Check for Hue App updates.
