Philips CA6500/63 Milk Frother Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your Philips CA6500/63 Milk Frother. This appliance is designed to create velvety smooth milk foam for a variety of hot and cold coffee and milk beverages. Please read these instructions carefully before first use and retain them for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons.

- Do not immerse the frother unit or power base in water or other liquids.
- Ensure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to your local mains voltage before connecting.
- Keep the appliance out of reach of children.
- Do not operate the appliance if the cord, plug, or the appliance itself is damaged.
- Use the appliance only for its intended purpose as described in this manual.
- Always place the frother on a stable, level, heat-resistant surface.
- Allow the frother to cool down before cleaning or storing.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Philips CA6500/63 Milk Frother consists of a frother unit and a separate power base. It features a non-stick coating for easy cleaning and a 360-degree base for convenient placement.

Components:

- Frother Unit (with whisk and non-stick interior)
- Power Base (with power cord)

4. SETUP

Before using your milk frother for the first time, follow these steps:

1. Unpack the appliance and remove all packaging materials.

2. Wipe the exterior of the frother unit with a damp cloth.
3. Clean the interior of the frother unit and the whisk with warm water and a small amount of dish soap. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
4. Place the power base on a stable, flat, and dry surface.
5. Ensure the frother unit is properly seated on the power base. The 360-degree design allows placement from any angle.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Philips CA6500/63 Milk Frother can prepare both hot and cold milk foam.

5.1. Preparing Hot Milk Foam

1. Ensure the frother unit is clean and dry.
2. Pour cold milk into the frother unit. Do not exceed the maximum fill line for frothing (120 ml), which is sufficient for approximately two cups of frothed milk.
3. Place the lid securely on the frother unit.
4. Place the frother unit onto the power base.
5. Press the power button once. The button will illuminate, indicating that the frothing process has started. The frother will automatically shut off when the milk reaches the optimal temperature and consistency.
6. Carefully remove the frother unit from the base and pour the frothed milk into your beverage.

5.2. Preparing Cold Milk Foam

1. Follow steps 1-4 from 'Preparing Hot Milk Foam'.
2. Press and hold the power button for approximately 2 seconds. The button will illuminate, and the frother will begin to froth the milk without heating. The frother will automatically shut off after the cold frothing cycle is complete.
3. Carefully remove the frother unit from the base and pour the frothed milk into your beverage.

Note: For best results, use fresh, cold milk. The quality of foam may vary depending on the type and fat content of the milk.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your frother. The non-stick coating facilitates easy cleaning.

1. Always unplug the power base from the mains outlet and allow the frother unit to cool down completely before cleaning.
2. Remove the frother unit from the power base.
3. Wash the interior of the frother unit and the whisk with warm water and a mild dishwashing liquid. Use a soft sponge or cloth to avoid scratching the non-stick coating.
4. Rinse the frother unit thoroughly under running water.
5. Dry all parts completely before reassembling or storing.
6. Wipe the exterior of the frother unit and the power base with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the power base in water.
7. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents, scourers, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the surfaces.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Philips CA6500/63 Milk Frother, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Frother does not start:**
 - Ensure the power base is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
 - Check that the frother unit is correctly placed on the power base.
 - Verify that the power button is pressed firmly.
- **Poor milk foam quality or no foam:**
 - Ensure you are using fresh, cold milk. Different types of milk (e.g., skim, whole, plant-based) may produce varying foam results.
 - Do not overfill the frother unit; ensure milk is below the maximum fill line.
 - Ensure the whisk is properly installed and clean.
 - Clean the frother thoroughly, as milk residue can affect performance.
- **Milk is not heating:**
 - Ensure you have pressed the power button once for hot frothing, not held it down for cold frothing.
 - If the frother has been used recently, allow it to cool down before attempting to heat milk again.
