SETUP

Unboxing and Initial Inspection

1. Carefully remove the watch and its accessories from the luxurious gift box.
2. Verify that all components are present: the TW Steel TW996 watch, the Guarantee card, and the Cleaning cloth.
3. Inspect the watch for any visible damage or defects.

Setting the Time and Date

1. **Unscrew the Crown:** The TW996 features a screwed crown for enhanced water resistance. Gently unscrew the crown counter-clockwise until it pops out to position 1.
2. **Set the Date (if applicable):** Pull the crown out to position 2 (first click). Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise

to adjust the date.

3. **Set the Time:** Pull the crown out further to position 3 (second click). Turn the crown to move the hour and minute hands. Ensure you set the correct AM/PM time.
4. **Push and Screw Down the Crown:** Once the time and date are set, push the crown back into position 1, then carefully screw it back down clockwise until it is securely tightened against the case. This is crucial for maintaining water resistance.

OPERATING THE CHRONOGRAPH FUNCTION

Your TW Steel TW996 watch is equipped with a powerful chronograph movement, allowing you to measure elapsed time with precision.

Chronograph Pushers

- **Pusher A (Top Pusher):** Starts and stops the chronograph.
- **Pusher B (Bottom Pusher):** Resets the chronograph to zero.

Using the Chronograph

1. **Start:** Press Pusher A to start the chronograph. The large second hand (chronograph second hand) will begin to move, along with the minute and hour sub-dials.
2. **Stop:** Press Pusher A again to stop the chronograph. The elapsed time will be indicated by the chronograph second, minute, and hour hands on their respective sub-dials.
3. **Reset:** After stopping the chronograph, press Pusher B to reset all chronograph hands to their zero positions.
4. **Split Time (if applicable):** Some chronographs allow for split-time measurement. Refer to the specific movement's detailed instructions if this feature is desired.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will ensure your TW Steel watch remains in excellent condition for years to come.

- **Cleaning:** Use the provided cleaning cloth to gently wipe the watch case, crystal, and strap regularly to remove dust, dirt, and fingerprints. For more stubborn marks, a slightly damp, soft cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying.
- **Water Resistance (10 ATM):** Your watch is water resistant up to 10 ATM (100 meters / 330 feet). This means it is suitable for swimming, snorkeling, and showering. However, it is not suitable for high-impact water sports or diving. Always ensure the crown is securely screwed down before any contact with water. Do not operate the crown or pushers when the watch is wet or submerged.
- **Temperature Extremes:** Avoid exposing your watch to extreme temperatures (hot or cold) or sudden temperature changes, as this can affect the movement and seals.
- **Chemicals:** Keep the watch away from chemicals such as solvents, detergents, perfumes, and cosmetics, as they can damage the case, strap, or seals.
- **Magnetic Fields:** Strong magnetic fields can affect the accuracy of quartz watches. Avoid placing your watch near strong magnets, such as those found in speakers, refrigerators, or certain electronic devices.
- **Strap Care:** The leather strap should be kept dry and clean. Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight or moisture, which can cause the leather to crack or discolor.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your TW Steel watch, please refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **Watch Not Running:**

- Check if the crown is fully pushed in and screwed down.
- The battery may need replacement. Contact an authorized service center.

- **Time Inaccurate:**

- Ensure the time was set correctly (AM/PM).
- Strong magnetic fields can affect accuracy. Move the watch away from magnetic sources.
- Battery may be low.

- **Chronograph Hands Not Resetting to Zero:**

- Press Pusher B firmly. If they still do not reset, there might be a need for calibration or service.

- **Condensation Under Crystal:**

- This indicates a breach in water resistance. Immediately take the watch to an authorized service center to prevent further damage.
