# AXON K-88 Rechargeable In-Ear Hearing Aid Instruction Manual

Model: K-88

## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The AXON K-88 is a compact, rechargeable in-ear hearing aid designed to amplify sound for individuals with severe hearing loss. Its discreet design and adjustable tone control offer an enhanced listening experience, filtering out unwanted noise for clearer sound perception.

### Key Features:

- Rechargeable function, eliminating the need for frequent battery changes.
- Discreet in-ear design with an internal speaker for smooth sound delivery.
- Effective filtering of unwanted background noise.
- Moisture-resistant construction for enhanced durability.
- Separate wire and earphone components for convenient and safe use.
- Advanced technology for reduced electromagnetic interference.
- Adjustable tone control for personalized sound settings.

## 2. SETUP

### 2.1 Unboxing and Component Check

Carefully unpack all items from the packaging. Ensure the following components are present:

- AXON K-88 Hearing Aid Unit
- Charging Adapter
- USB Charging Cable
- Assorted Ear Tips (various sizes)
- Instruction Manual
- Carrying Case

### 2.2 Initial Charging

1. Connect the USB charging cable to the charging port on the hearing aid unit.
2. Plug the other end of the USB cable into the provided charging adapter.
3. Insert the charging adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
4. Allow the device to charge fully before first use. The charging indicator light will typically change color or turn off when charging is complete. A full charge may take several hours.

**Note:** The AXON K-88 features a built-in rechargeable battery that is not user-replaceable.

### 2.3 Selecting and Fitting Ear Tips

1. Choose an ear tip size that provides a comfortable and snug fit in your ear canal. A proper fit is crucial for optimal sound quality and to prevent feedback (whistling).
2. Gently attach the selected ear tip to the sound outlet of the hearing aid.
3. Ensure the ear tip is securely fastened before inserting the device into your ear.

## 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 3.1 Powering On/Off

- To turn the hearing aid **ON**, locate the power button or switch on the device and move it to the 'ON' position.
- To turn the hearing aid **OFF**, move the power button or switch to the 'OFF' position. Always turn off the device when not in use to conserve battery life.

### 3.2 Volume Adjustment

The AXON K-88 features a button control for volume adjustment.

1. Before inserting the hearing aid, set the volume to the lowest comfortable level.
2. Once inserted, gradually increase the volume using the control button until the desired listening level is achieved. Avoid excessively high volumes to prevent discomfort or potential hearing damage.

### 3.3 Wearing the Hearing Aid

1. With the volume set low and the appropriate ear tip attached, gently insert the hearing aid into your ear canal.
2. Ensure it sits comfortably and securely. Do not force the device into your ear.
3. Adjust the volume as needed once the device is properly seated.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

---

### 4.1 Cleaning the Device

Regular cleaning helps maintain optimal performance and hygiene.

- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the hearing aid unit daily.
- Remove ear tips and clean them separately with a mild soap and water solution. Rinse thoroughly and allow them to air dry completely before reattaching.
- Never use harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive cleaners on the hearing aid.
- Avoid getting moisture into the electronic components of the device.

### 4.2 Storage

- When not in use, store the AXON K-88 in its provided carrying case.
- Keep the device in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and humidity.
- Store out of reach of children and pets.

### 4.3 Battery Care

- Charge the device regularly to maintain battery health.
- Avoid completely draining the battery frequently, as this can reduce its overall lifespan.
- If storing the device for an extended period, ensure it has a partial charge (around 50%) and recharge it every few months.

Battery not charging	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Charging cable or adapter not connected properly</li> <li>Faulty charging cable or adapter</li> <li>Power outlet issue</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ensure all connections are secure</li> <li>Try a different USB cable or adapter (if compatible)</li> <li>Test the power outlet with another device</li> </ul>
