1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Apple AirPort Express A1392 wireless router. The AirPort Express is designed to provide 802.11n Wi-Fi connectivity, AirPlay audio streaming, and network extension capabilities for your home or small office.

It features 600 Mbps wireless speeds, a 1-Port 10/100 Ethernet connection, and supports dual-band frequency operation.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before you begin, ensure all items are present:

- Apple AirPort Express A1392 Unit
- Power Cable (US plug type)

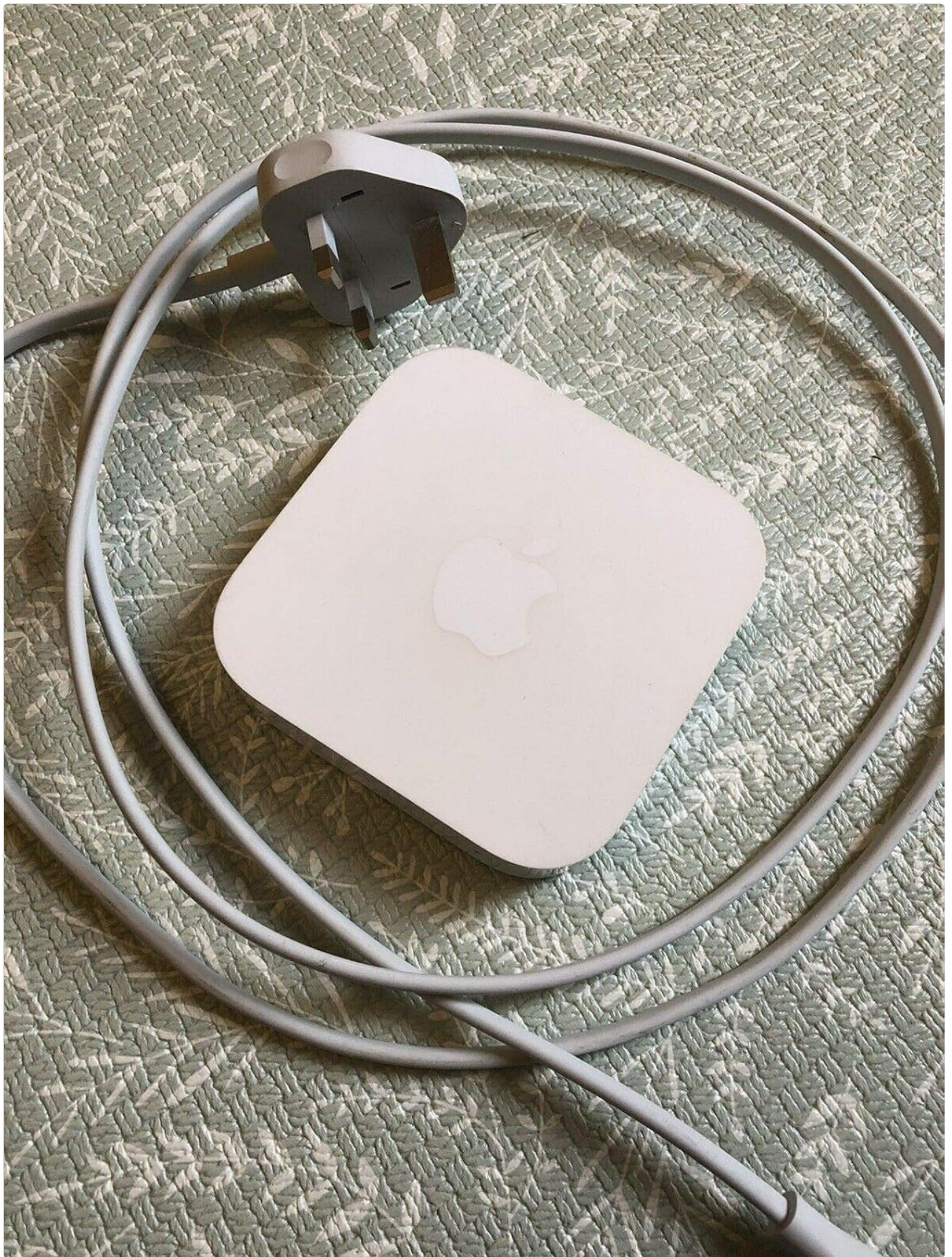


Figure 2.1: The Apple AirPort Express A1392 unit shown with its included power cable. The unit is a compact, square white device, and the cable has a US-style plug.

3. DEVICE OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the ports and indicators on your AirPort Express.

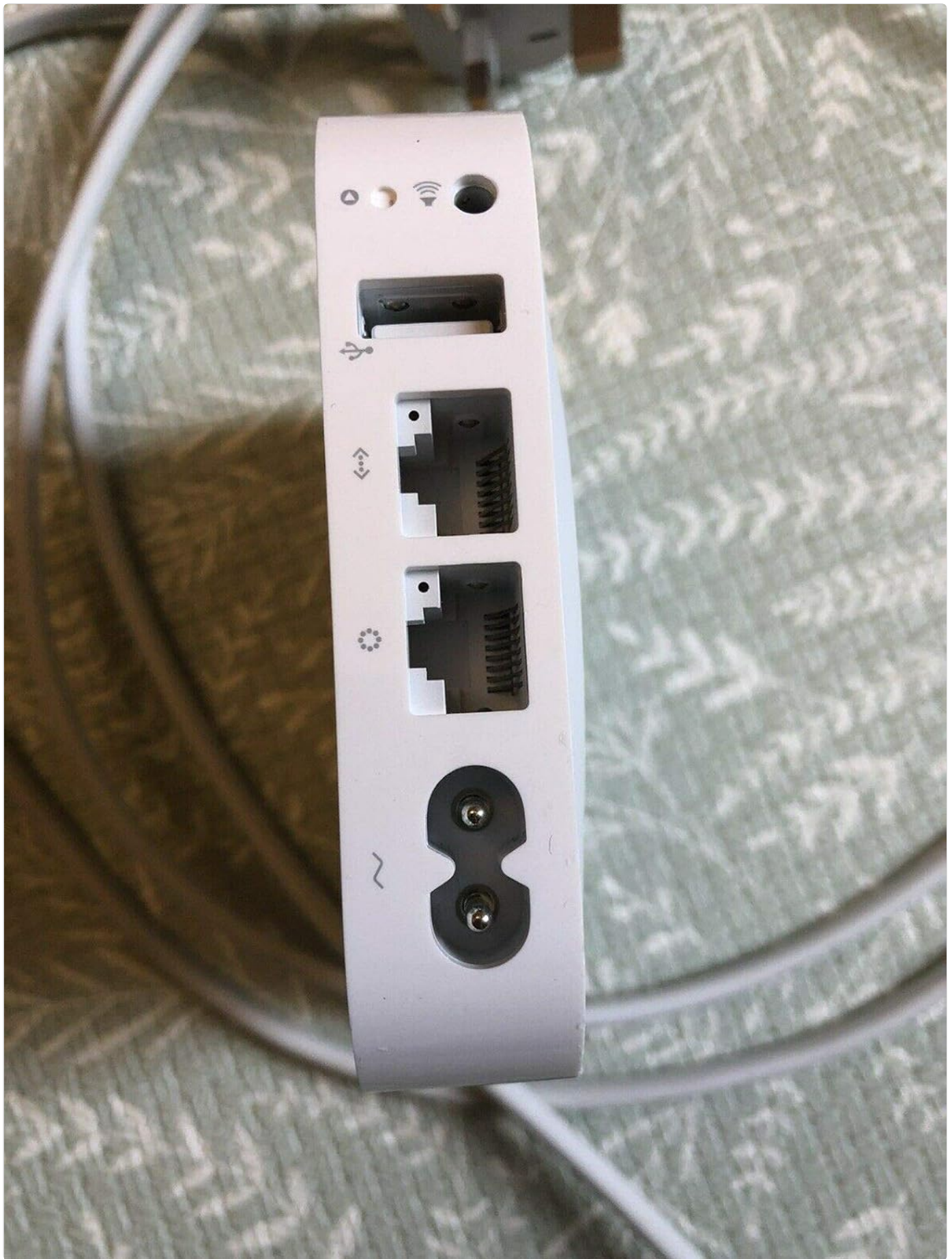


Figure 3.1: Side view of the AirPort Express A1392, highlighting its various ports and indicator lights. From top to bottom, these include status lights, a USB port, an Ethernet WAN/LAN port, an audio output jack, and the power input.

3.1. Ports and Indicators

- **Status Light:** Indicates the device's current status (e.g., green for ready, amber for warning).
- **USB Port:** For connecting a printer to share over the network.
- **Ethernet Port (WAN/LAN):** Connects to your modem for internet access or to a wired device.
- **Audio Out Jack:** For connecting to speakers for AirPlay audio streaming.
- **Power Input:** Connects the device to an electrical outlet using the provided power cable.

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your AirPort Express for the first time.

1. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cable into the AirPort Express and then into a wall outlet. The status light will glow amber.

2. **Connect to Modem (Optional):** If using the AirPort Express as your primary router, connect an Ethernet cable from your broadband modem to the Ethernet port on the AirPort Express.
3. **Initial Configuration:**
 - On your Mac or iOS device, open Wi-Fi settings and select the new AirPort Express network (e.g., "AirPort Express XXXXXX").
 - Open *AirPort Utility* (pre-installed on Mac, available on App Store for iOS).
 - Follow the on-screen instructions to configure your network name (SSID), password, and other settings.
 - The status light will turn green once setup is complete and the device is connected to the internet.
4. **AirPlay Setup (Optional):** To use AirPlay, connect speakers to the audio out jack. You can then select the AirPort Express as an audio output device from your Apple devices.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Connecting Devices

- **Wi-Fi:** On your device, select your configured Wi-Fi network name and enter the password.
- **Wired:** Connect an Ethernet cable from your device to the Ethernet port on the AirPort Express (if configured as a LAN port).

5.2. AirPlay Audio Streaming

Once speakers are connected to the AirPort Express, you can stream audio wirelessly from iTunes on your computer or from music apps on your iOS device. Select the AirPort Express from the AirPlay icon in your audio playback controls.

5.3. Printer Sharing

Connect a compatible USB printer to the USB port on the AirPort Express. Ensure your computer has the necessary printer drivers installed. The printer will then be discoverable on your network.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Firmware Updates:** Regularly check for and install firmware updates using AirPort Utility to ensure optimal performance and security.
- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the device. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosols.
- **Placement:** Place the AirPort Express in a central location, away from obstructions and other electronic devices that may cause interference.
- **Restarting:** If you experience network issues, try restarting the AirPort Express by unplugging it from power for 10 seconds and then plugging it back in.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common issues and their solutions:

- **No Internet Connection:**
 - Check modem connection and status lights.
 - Ensure Ethernet cable is securely connected to the AirPort Express.
 - Restart both your modem and AirPort Express.
 - Verify settings in AirPort Utility.

- **Slow Wi-Fi Speed:**
 - Relocate the AirPort Express to a more central position.
 - Check for interference from other devices (cordless phones, microwaves).
 - Ensure your devices are compatible with 802.11n.
- **AirPlay Not Working:**
 - Ensure speakers are properly connected to the audio out jack.
 - Verify that the AirPort Express is selected as the audio output device on your source.
 - Check network connectivity.
- **Status Light is Amber/Flashing:**
 - Open AirPort Utility to view diagnostic messages and recommended actions.
 - This often indicates a network issue or a pending firmware update.
