2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury.

- **Read all instructions:** Familiarize yourself with the appliance before use.
- **Hot steam:** Steam is extremely hot and can cause burns. Keep hands and face away from steam outlets.
- **Do not overfill:** Fill the water tank only to the recommended capacity.
- **Unplug when not in use:** Always unplug the steam cleaner from the electrical outlet before filling, emptying, or performing maintenance.
- **Use on appropriate surfaces:** Ensure surfaces are suitable for steam cleaning. Test on an inconspicuous area first.
- **Keep away from children and pets:** Do not allow children or pets near the operating steam cleaner.
- **Use only distilled water:** To prevent mineral buildup and prolong the life of your appliance, use only distilled or demineralized water.

4. SETUP

4.1 Filling the Water Tank

1. Ensure the steam cleaner is unplugged and cool.
2. Unscrew the safety cap on top of the unit.
3. Using the integrated funnel, carefully pour up to 1.6 liters of distilled or demineralized water into the tank. Do not overfill.
4. Securely screw the safety cap back on.

4.2 Attaching Accessories

Select the appropriate accessory for your cleaning task. Attach it firmly to the steam lance or extension tubes until it clicks into place. To remove, press the release button and pull the accessory off.

4.3 Powering On

1. Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.
2. Press the power button on the front of the unit. The indicator light will illuminate.
3. Allow approximately 7-8 minutes for the unit to heat up and produce steam. The indicator light will change when ready.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 General Operation

Once the unit is ready, press the steam trigger on the handle to release steam. For continuous steam, engage the lock button on the handle. Always use a microfiber cloth or pad to wipe away loosened dirt and moisture.

5.2 Specific Applications

Floors and Tiles

Attach the floor tool with a microfiber pad and extension tubes. Move the tool slowly over the surface to allow the steam to penetrate and loosen dirt. For heavily soiled areas, make multiple passes.

Grout Cleaning

Use a small nylon brush attached to the steam lance. Apply steam directly to the grout lines and scrub gently. Wipe away residue with a clean cloth.

Kitchen Surfaces and Appliances

The steam lance with a small brush or triangular tool is effective for cleaning countertops, sinks, stovetops, and oven interiors. Steam helps to dissolve grease and grime.

Upholstery and Furniture

Attach the triangular tool with a microfiber cloth. Hold the tool a few inches from the fabric and apply steam in short bursts. Wipe with the cloth to remove dirt and refresh the fabric. Always test on an inconspicuous area first.

Windows and Mirrors

Use the window tool. Apply steam to a section of the glass, then use the squeegee blade to wipe away moisture and dirt. For best results, wipe the blade clean after each pass.

Wallpaper Removal

Attach the triangular tool with a microfiber cloth. Hold the tool against the wallpaper for a few seconds to allow steam to penetrate, then gently peel away the paper. Repeat as needed.

Mattress and Pillow Sanitization

Use the triangular tool with a clean microfiber cloth. Move the tool slowly over the mattress surface, allowing the steam to penetrate. This helps to eliminate dust mites and bed bugs.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning the Unit

After each use, ensure the unit is unplugged and cool. Wipe the exterior with a damp cloth. Clean accessories as needed; microfiber pads can be machine washed.

6.2 Descaling

Regular descaling is crucial to maintain performance, especially if using tap water (though distilled water is recommended). Consult the Dupray website or customer support for detailed descaling instructions specific to your model.

6.3 Storage

Empty any remaining water from the tank. Store the steam cleaner and its accessories in a cool, dry place, away

from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure the power cord is neatly wrapped.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam or low steam output	Water tank empty; Unit not heated sufficiently; Mineral buildup.	Refill water tank; Allow full heating time (7-8 minutes); Perform descaling.
Water leaking from nozzle/accessories	Accessories not properly attached; Condensation buildup; Overfilling.	Ensure accessories are securely attached; Point nozzle away and press trigger to release initial condensation; Do not overfill.
Unit not turning on	Not plugged in; Power outlet issue; Unit malfunction.	Check power connection; Test outlet with another device; Contact customer support.
