1. INTRODUCTION

3. SETUP

Follow these steps to properly set up your Lakewood Take Down Shotgun Case:

1. **Disassemble Shotgun:** Ensure your shotgun is unloaded and disassembled into its primary components: stock, forearm, and barrel(s).
2. **Open Case:** Unzip the case completely and lay it flat on a clean, stable surface.
3. **Place Stock:** Carefully place the shotgun stock into its designated pre-cut foam cavity. Ensure it sits snugly and is fully supported.
4. **Place Forearm:** Position the forearm into its corresponding pre-cut foam cavity.
5. **Place Barrel(s):** Insert the barrel(s) into their respective pre-cut foam cavities. If you have multiple barrels, ensure each is placed in its dedicated slot.
6. **Add Choke Tubes:** Place up to 5 choke tubes into the provided slots.
7. **Store Accessories:** Utilize the large storage area for any additional accessories you wish to transport, ensuring they do not interfere with the firearm components.

Verify that all components are securely seated within their cavities before proceeding to close the case.

4. OPERATING THE CASE

Once your shotgun components and accessories are properly placed, follow these steps to operate and transport your case:

- **Closing the Case:** Carefully bring the two halves of the case together, ensuring the foam inserts align perfectly. Engage the full-length zipper, pulling it smoothly to close the case securely. The case features a push lock closure for added security.
- **Carrying:** Use the sturdy wrap handles for comfortable and balanced carrying. Ensure the handles are securely fastened together before lifting.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the case in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to preserve the integrity of the foam and exterior material.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your Lakewood Take Down Shotgun Case:

- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the case with a damp cloth and mild soap if necessary. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Allow to air dry completely.
- **Interior Foam Care:** The foam inserts are designed for durability. If they become dusty, gently vacuum with a soft brush attachment. Do not wash or submerge the foam.
- **Zipper Maintenance:** Periodically check the zipper for any debris. If it becomes stiff, a small amount of zipper lubricant can be applied.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the case for any signs of wear, tear, or damage to the exterior fabric, handles, or foam inserts. Address any issues promptly to maintain optimal protection.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Lakewood Take Down Shotgun Case, consider the following common solutions:

- **Components Not Fitting:** Ensure all shotgun components are fully disassembled and oriented correctly within their respective pre-cut foam cavities. Do not force components into place.
- **Case Not Closing Properly:** Verify that no items are obstructing the zipper path or preventing the two halves of the case from meeting flush. Check that all firearm components are seated deeply within the foam.
- **Zipper Stiffness:** Clean any visible debris from the zipper teeth. Apply a small amount of silicone-based zipper lubricant if the zipper is difficult to move.
