Introduction

Boasting a new 26.1MP APS-C X-Trans CMOS 4 sensor and X-Processor 4 Quad-Core CPU, the X-T30 provides beginners, advanced amateurs, and professionals with fast auto-focus, strong face detection, and power to create high-resolution stills with notable sharpness and clarity. Combined with its increased sensitivity range up to ISO 51200 and the ability to record 10-bit, 4:2:2 DCI 4K video through the camera's HDMI port, the X-T30 is truly the perfect camera for releasing your creativity.

1. Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that the following items are present:

- Camera Body
- XF18-55mm Lens
- Battery
- Battery Charger
- Strap

2. Attaching the Lens

- 1. Remove the body cap from the camera and the rear lens cap from the lens.
- 2. Align the white dot on the lens with the white dot on the camera body.
- 3. Rotate the lens clockwise until it clicks into place.

3. Inserting the Battery and Memory Card

- 1. Open the battery/memory card compartment cover on the bottom of the camera.
- 2. Insert a charged battery with the correct orientation until it locks.
- 3. Insert a compatible SD, SDHC, or SDXC memory card into the slot until it clicks.
- 4. Close the compartment cover securely.

4. Initial Power On and Settings

Turn the camera on using the power switch. Follow the on-screen prompts to set the date, time, and language.

OPERATING THE CAMERA

1. Basic Photography Modes

The X-T30 offers various shooting modes for different scenarios:

- Advanced SR Auto Mode: Easily activated with a lever, this mode automatically selects optimal shooting settings from 58
 presets for a given scene.
- Manual Controls: Utilize the dedicated dials for shutter speed and exposure compensation for precise control over your images.

2. Autofocus System

The camera features a 425-point hybrid autofocus system with advanced tracking and face detection capabilities.

- Face Detection: The X-Processor 4 Quad Core-CPU provides fast and accurate face detection for moving subjects.
- Eye Detection AF: Works in AF-C (Continuous Autofocus) mode for accurate focus tracking of moving portrait subjects.
- Low-Light Performance: Phase detection AF operates down to -3EV, allowing for performance in challenging low-light conditions.

3. Video Recording

The X-T30 is capable of high-quality video capture:

• 4K Video: Record 4K DCI 2160p video at 30 frames per second.

- Slow Motion: Capture 1080p video at 120 frames per second for super slow-motion effects.
- External Recording: Output 10-bit, 4:2:2 color video through the camera's HDMI port for enhanced color fidelity.

4. Wireless Connectivity

The camera includes built-in Wi-Fi and Bluetooth V.4.2 for seamless digital communication.

• FUJIFILM Camera Remote App: Use the free app to wirelessly control the camera or transfer images to smart devices.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning the Lens: Use a soft, lint-free cloth and lens cleaning solution to gently wipe the lens surface. Avoid touching the glass directly with your fingers.
- Cleaning the Camera Body: Wipe the camera body with a dry, soft cloth. For stubborn dirt, use a slightly damp cloth and then dry thoroughly.
- Battery Care: Store batteries in a cool, dry place. Avoid fully discharging batteries for extended periods.
- Sensor Cleaning: If dust spots appear on your images, consult a professional camera service for sensor cleaning. Attempting to clean the sensor yourself without proper tools and knowledge can cause damage.
- Storage: When not in use, store the camera in a dry, dust-free environment, preferably in a camera bag or case.

Troubleshooting

Common Issues and Solutions:

- Camera Not Turning On: Ensure the battery is fully charged and correctly inserted. Check if the battery contacts are clean.
- Images Are Blurry: Verify that the lens is properly attached and clean. Check your focus mode (AF-S, AF-C, Manual) and ensure the camera is focusing correctly. Increase shutter speed in low light conditions or use image stabilization.
- **Memory Card Error:** Ensure the memory card is inserted correctly and is not full or corrupted. Try formatting the card (this will erase all data) or using a different card.
- Video Recording Stops Unexpectedly: Check if the memory card has sufficient free space and is fast enough for 4K video recording (V30 speed class recommended). Ensure the battery has enough charge.
- Wireless Connection Issues: Ensure Wi-Fi and Bluetooth are enabled on both the camera and your smart device. Restart both devices and try reconnecting through the FUJIFILM Camera Remote app.
