SETUP

Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge your PDX Elite Moto-bator 2.

1. Locate the charging port on the device.

2. Connect the provided charging cable to the port and plug the other end into a suitable USB power source.
3. The indicator light (if present) will show charging status. Refer to the packaging for specific light indications.
4. Allow the device to charge completely before disconnecting.

Initial Preparation

For hygienic reasons, it is recommended to clean the internal sleeve before the first use. Refer to the "Maintenance and Cleaning" section for detailed instructions.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Controls Overview

The device features a control panel with distinct buttons for various functions:

- **T Button:** Controls Thrusting function.
- **S Button:** Controls Suction function.
- **R Button:** Likely for Recharge/Reset or another mode.
- **V Button:** Controls Vibration function.

Basic Operation

1. **Power On/Off:** Press and hold the Power button (likely the 'R' button or a dedicated power button if present) for a few seconds to turn the device on or off.

2. **Activating Functions:** Press and hold the 'T', 'S', or 'V' button to activate the respective function.
3. **Changing Modes/Intensities:** While a function is active, quick-press the corresponding button ('T', 'S', or 'V') to cycle through different modes or intensity levels.
4. **Applying Lubricant:** For optimal experience and to protect the device's electronics, always apply a water-based lubricant directly to the user, not into the device's sleeve.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning and maintenance are crucial for the hygiene and longevity of your PDX Elite Moto-bator 2. The device is waterproof, allowing for thorough cleaning.

Disassembly for Cleaning

1. Ensure the device is powered off.
2. Carefully unscrew or detach the retaining ring at the base of the device.
3. Gently pull out the internal sleeve from the main unit.

Cleaning Instructions

1. Wash the internal sleeve thoroughly with warm water and a mild, toy-safe soap. Rinse completely to remove all soap residue.
2. Clean the exterior of the main unit with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not submerge the main unit in water for extended periods, despite its waterproof rating, to protect internal electronics.

3. Allow all components to air dry completely before reassembly. Ensure no moisture remains, especially in crevices.

Reassembly

1. Once dry, carefully insert the internal sleeve back into the main unit, ensuring it is correctly aligned.
2. Reattach the retaining ring, screwing it firmly until secure.

Storage

Store the device in a clean, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your PDX Elite Moto-bator 2, please refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not turn on.	Low battery; Device not charged.	Ensure the device is fully charged. Check charging cable and power source.
Functions (thrusting, vibration, suction) are weak or not working.	Low battery; Internal mechanism obstruction; Device malfunction.	Recharge the device. Disassemble and clean the internal sleeve and ensure no debris. If issues persist, contact customer support.
Device is unusually noisy.	Internal component issue; Lack of lubrication during use.	Ensure proper lubrication is applied to the user before use. If noise persists, it may indicate an internal issue requiring professional assistance.
Device fails to recharge.	Faulty charging cable/adaptor; Damaged charging port; Battery issue.	Try a different USB power source or charging cable. Inspect the charging port for damage. If the problem continues, the battery may need replacement or the device may be faulty.
