
The SIMPLICITY S8872 sewing pattern package typically includes:

## SETUP AND PREPARATION

### 1. Choosing Your Size

Refer to the body measurement chart below to select the appropriate pattern size. It is recommended to choose a size based on your bust measurement, then adjust for waist and hip if necessary.

**Fabrics:** Chambray, Cotton Lawn, Cotton Types, Double Georgette, lightweight Linen Types, Shirtings, Silky Types. **B** in Scalloped Edge Fabrics only. Extra fabric needed to match plaids, stripes or one-way design fabrics.

**Notions:** Thread. **A,B:** One pkg. of  $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide single fold bias tape,  $\frac{1}{8}$  yd. of  $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide elastic. **C:** 1 yd. of  $\frac{1}{4}$ " to  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide flexible trim or mini pom pom fringe,  $\frac{1}{8}$  yd. of  $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide cording,  $\frac{1}{4}$  yd. of  $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide elastic. **D:** 3 yd. of mini pom pom fringe,  $\frac{1}{8}$  yd. of  $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide elastic.

**Mercerie:** Fil. **A,B:** Un paquet de ruban simple de biais de 1.3cm de large, 0.60m d'élastique de 6mm de large, **C:** 0.90m de garniture extensible ou mini frange de pompons de 6mm à 1cm de large, 1.30m de cordon de 6mm de large, 1.20m d'élastique de 6mm de large. **D:** 2.70m de mini frange de pompons, 0.60m d'élastique de 6mm de large.

**Mercería:** Hilo. **A,B:** Un paquete de cinta de bies sencillo de 1.3cm de ancho, 0.60m de elástico de 6mm de ancho, **C:** 0.90m de adorno estirable o de mini flecos con pompones de 6mm a 1cm de ancho, 1.30m de cordón de 6mm de ancho, 1.20m de elástico de 6mm de ancho. **D:** 2.70m de mini flecos con pompones, 0.60m de elástico de 6mm de ancho.

## 2. Fabric Selection

Recommended fabrics for this pattern include: Chambray, Linen, Cotton, Cotton Blends, Crepe, Double Georgette, Gauze, Lightweight Linen Types, and Shirting. For View B, only use Scalloped Edge Fabrics. Consider pre-washing your fabric according to its care instructions to prevent shrinkage after the garment is made.

## 3. Notions Required

Ensure you have the following notions before beginning your project:

- Thread (matching your fabric color)
- **For Views A & B:** One package of ½" wide single fold bias tape, ¾ yd. of ½" wide elastic.
- **For View C:** 1 yd. of ½" wide flexible trim or 1 yd. of mini pom pom fringe, ¾ yd. of ½" wide cording, 1¼ yd. of ½" wide elastic.
- **For View D:** ¾ yd. of mini pom pom fringe, ¾ yd. of ½" wide elastic.

## OPERATING (SEWING INSTRUCTIONS)

The detailed sewing instructions, including cutting layouts and step-by-step assembly, are provided on the enclosed paper instruction sheet. Please refer to this sheet for precise guidance on:

- Pattern piece identification and preparation.
- Fabric cutting layouts for different views and sizes.
- Step-by-step sewing construction, including seams, hems, and finishing techniques.
- Instructions for attaching elastic, bias tape, and trims as specified for each view.

Follow the instructions carefully, paying attention to seam allowances and pressing steps for a professional finish.

## MAINTENANCE (CARE OF FINISHED GARMENT)

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Once your dress is complete, follow the care instructions appropriate for the fabric you have chosen. General care tips include:

- Wash garment according to fabric type (e.g., cold water, gentle cycle).
- Use mild detergent.
- Tumble dry low or hang dry to prevent shrinkage and maintain shape.
- Iron on appropriate temperature setting for your fabric.

## TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON SEWING ISSUES

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While sewing, you might encounter common challenges. Here are some general tips:

- **Fabric Slippage:** Use sharp pins, a walking foot, or tissue paper under delicate fabrics.
- **Uneven Seams:** Ensure consistent seam allowance by using a seam guide on your sewing machine.
- **Gathering Issues:** If gathers are uneven, try two rows of basting stitches and pull both threads simultaneously.
- **Fit Problems:** Always make a muslin (test garment) from inexpensive fabric before cutting your main fabric, especially if you are unsure about sizing or making alterations.
