1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the proper installation, maintenance, and care of your AIRCARE HDC311 Replacement Wicking Humidifier Filter. Designed to ensure optimal performance and clean moisture output, these filters are essential for maintaining the efficiency of your AIRCARE humidifier. Regular replacement of the wicking filter is crucial for effective humidification and to prevent mineral buildup.

3. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to properly install your new AIRCARE HDC311 wicking filter:

1. **Unplug the Humidifier:** Always ensure the humidifier is unplugged from the power outlet before performing any maintenance or installation.
2. **Remove Humidifier Cover:** Carefully remove the top cover or housing of your AIRCARE humidifier to access the filter compartment. Refer to your humidifier's specific user manual for detailed instructions on accessing the filter.
3. **Remove Old Filters:** Locate and remove the old, saturated wicking filters. Dispose of them according to local regulations.
4. **Clean Filter Holders:** It is recommended to clean the filter holders and the humidifier's water reservoir thoroughly before installing new filters. This helps prevent the growth of mold and bacteria.
5. **Install New Filters:** Place the new AIRCARE HDC311 wicking filters into the designated filter holders. Ensure they are seated correctly and securely. The filters are designed for an exact fit.
6. **Replace Humidifier Cover:** Carefully reattach the humidifier's top cover or housing.
7. **Refill Water Reservoir:** Fill the water reservoir with clean, fresh water.

8. **Plug In and Operate:** Plug the humidifier back into the power outlet and resume normal operation.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To ensure the longevity of your humidifier and the effectiveness of your filters, consider the following maintenance tips:

- **Filter Replacement Frequency:** Wicking filters should be replaced regularly, typically every season or as needed, depending on water hardness and usage. Signs of needing replacement include reduced moisture output, hardening of the filter, or a noticeable odor.
- **Water Quality:** Using distilled or demineralized water can extend filter life and reduce mineral buildup.
- **Cleaning:** Periodically clean the humidifier's water reservoir and other components according to the humidifier's user manual to prevent mold and bacteria growth. Some users find adding a humidifier treatment or disinfectant to the water helps maintain cleanliness.
- **Storage:** If storing the humidifier for an extended period, remove and discard the old filters, clean the unit thoroughly, and allow all components to dry completely before storage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your humidifier's performance after installing new filters, consider the following:

- **Reduced Moisture Output:**

- Ensure filters are fully saturated with water. New filters may take some time to absorb water completely.
- Check if the humidifier's water reservoir is adequately filled.
- Verify that the humidifier fan is operating correctly.
- Inspect filters for excessive mineral buildup or hardening, which indicates they need replacement.

- **Unpleasant Odor:**

- An odor often indicates bacterial or mold growth. Replace filters immediately.
- Thoroughly clean and sanitize the humidifier's water reservoir and all components.
- Use fresh, clean water and consider adding a humidifier treatment product.

- **Filter Not Fitting Correctly:**

- Double-check that you have the correct HDC311 filter for your specific AIRCARE humidifier model (EA1201 or EA1208).
- Ensure the filter is inserted into the designated slot without obstruction.
