# Bosch GAS 12-25 Professional Wet/Dry Extractor User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Bosch GAS 12-25 Professional Wet/Dry Extractor is designed for efficient cleaning in various environments, offering powerful suction for both wet and dry applications. This extractor features a 1250W motor, a HEPA H13 filter for capturing fine dust, and a 25-liter capacity. Its patented filter cleaning technology ensures consistent suction performance and extends filter life. The compact and portable design allows for easy transport and flexible use across different job sites.

## 2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

### 3. SETUP

---

Follow these steps to set up your Bosch GAS 12-25 Professional Wet/Dry Extractor for use.

1. **Connect the Hose and Accessories:** Securely attach the 3-meter hose to the extractor's inlet port. Then, connect the desired accessories, such as the crevice nozzle or antistatic pipe, to the end of the hose. Ensure all connections are tight to prevent suction loss.

# HOW TO USE



1. Connect the hose and accessories to the extractor.



2. Switch on to start powerful wet or dry vacuuming.



3. Easily empty the container after cleaning is complete.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Operating the Bosch GAS 12-25 is straightforward. Ensure the unit is properly set up before powering on.

2. **Power On:** Plug the extractor into a suitable 230V power outlet. Locate the power switch on the unit and switch it to the 'ON' position to start the powerful wet or dry vacuuming.

- Emptying the Container:** Once cleaning is complete, or the container is full, switch off the extractor and unplug it. Carefully detach the hose and open the container latches. Empty the collected debris or liquid into an appropriate disposal area.




Image: Step 3 - Easily empty the container after cleaning is complete.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Bosch GAS 12-25 extractor.

### Filter Cleaning

The Bosch GAS 12-25 features patented filter cleaning technology to maintain consistent suction power. This system reduces the frequency of manual filter cleaning. The H13 HEPA filter captures 99.95% of fine dust particles, ensuring a cleaner workspace. The large surface pre-filter further enhances the main filter's lifespan, minimizing downtime.

- Periodically check the filters for excessive buildup.
- Refer to the full manual for detailed instructions on activating the patented filter cleaning mechanism or for manual cleaning procedures.
- Replace filters as needed to maintain filtration efficiency and suction power.

## General Cleaning

- Wipe down the exterior of the unit with a damp cloth.
- Ensure the container is clean and dry after wet extraction to prevent mold or odors.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your extractor, consult the following common troubleshooting tips.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No suction or weak suction	Hose or nozzle blocked; filter clogged; container full; loose connections	Check and clear blockages; clean or replace filter; empty container; ensure all connections are secure
Extractor does not turn on	No power supply; faulty power cord/switch	Check power outlet and cord; contact customer support if issue persists
Unusual noise during operation	Foreign object in fan/motor; damaged motor	Turn off and unplug, inspect for foreign objects; contact customer support
