INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your RIF6 XTV000212UK 61-Key Electronic Piano Keyboard. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper function and longevity.

SETUP

1. Assembling the Keyboard Stand and Stool

1. Unfold the X-style keyboard stand. Adjust the height to your preference using the locking mechanism.
2. Place the RIF6 61-Key Electronic Piano Keyboard securely on the stand. Ensure it is stable.
3. Unfold the padded stool and adjust its height for comfortable playing.

2. Connecting Power and Accessories

1. Connect the power adapter to the DC 12V input jack on the rear panel of the keyboard. Plug the adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
2. For portable use, the keyboard can also be powered by 8 x 1.5V 'D' batteries (not included). Insert batteries into the compartment on the underside of the keyboard.
3. Plug the sustain pedal into the 'SUSTAIN' jack on the rear panel.
4. For private practice, connect the over-ear headphones to the 'PHONES OUTPUT' jack.
5. To use the microphone, plug it into the 'MIC IN' jack.
6. Attach the music stand to the designated slots on the top panel of the keyboard.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Power On/Off

Press the **POWER** button located on the left side of the control panel to turn the keyboard on or off. The LCD display will illuminate upon power-on.

2. Volume Control


Adjust the overall volume using the **MASTER VOLUME** knob. Use the **VOLUME +/-** buttons for fine adjustments to accompaniment volume.

3. Tone/Voice Selection

The keyboard features 300 different tones. Press the **TONE** button, then use the numeric keypad (0-9) to enter the desired tone number. Refer to the tone list in the full instruction manual for available options.

4. Rhythm Selection

Select from 300 rhythms by pressing the **RHYTHM** button and entering the corresponding number via the numeric keypad. Use the **START/STOP** button to begin or end the rhythm.

5. Demo Songs

The keyboard includes 50 demo songs. Press the **DEMO** button to cycle through and play the pre-loaded songs.

6. Teaching Modes

The RIF6 keyboard offers three teaching modes to assist with learning:

- **Teach 1 (One Key):** Allows you to play any key to advance the melody. Focuses on rhythm and timing without requiring correct notes.
- **Teach 2 (Follow):** The keyboard waits for you to play the correct note before advancing the melody. This helps with note recognition.

- **Teach 3 (Ensemble):** The keyboard plays the accompaniment, and you play the melody. If you don't play the correct note within 3 seconds, the keyboard will play it for you.

To activate a teaching mode, press the corresponding **TEACH 1**, **TEACH 2**, or **TEACH 3** button, then select a song using the numeric keypad.

7. Recording and Playback

Press the **REC** button to enter recording mode. Play your desired melody. Press **PLAY** to listen to your recorded performance.

8. Sustain Pedal

Connect the sustain pedal to the 'SUSTAIN' jack. Pressing the pedal will sustain the notes played, similar to an acoustic piano.

9. Headphones and Microphone

Plug headphones into the 'PHONES OUTPUT' for silent practice. Connect the microphone to the 'MIC IN' jack to sing along while playing.

Power Up Your Way

Plug in and play or use 8 1.5V D batteries for portable playing.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your RIF6 keyboard, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the surface of the keyboard. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or waxes, as these can damage the finish.
- Storage:** Store the keyboard in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity. If storing for an extended period, remove batteries to prevent leakage.
- Handling:** Always handle the keyboard with care. Avoid dropping it or subjecting it to strong impacts.
- Power:** Disconnect the power adapter when the keyboard is not in use for prolonged periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your RIF6 keyboard, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **No Sound:**

- Check if the keyboard is powered on.
- Ensure the master volume is turned up.
- If headphones are plugged in, unplug them to check speaker output.
- Verify that the power adapter is securely connected or batteries are correctly inserted and charged.

- **Keys Not Responding:**

- Ensure the keyboard is powered on.
- If in a teaching mode, ensure you are pressing the correct keys as indicated.

- **Distorted Sound:**

- Lower the volume to see if distortion reduces.
- Check headphone connection if using headphones.


