# Francis Lofts & Bunks Queen Bunk Bed Instruction Manual

Model: Queen Bunk Bed

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use. Retain this manual for future reference.

- **Weight Capacity:** Exceeding the 2,000 lbs weight capacity per bunk may lead to structural instability and potential injury.
- **Assembly:** Improper assembly may result in product instability or collapse. Ensure all components are correctly installed and tightened.
- **Top Bunk Safety:** The top bunk is not recommended for children under 6 years of age.
- **Guardrails:** Always use the provided guardrails on the top bunk.
- **No Jumping:** Do not allow jumping on the bunk bed.
- **Mattress Size:** Use only Queen size mattresses that comply with the recommended dimensions to ensure proper fit and safety.

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Francis Lofts & Bunks Queen Bunk Bed requires two adults. Follow these general steps for proper installation. Refer to the separate assembly guide for detailed, step-by-step instructions and diagrams.

### Required Tools (Not Included):

- Hex key (often included with hardware)
- Phillips head screwdriver
- Adjustable wrench

### Included Components:

The package includes all necessary frame components, guardrails, and slats for both the upper and lower bunks. Verify all

parts are present before beginning assembly.

## Assembly Steps Overview:

1. Unpack all components and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratching.
2. Assemble the lower bunk frame according to the detailed instructions. Ensure all bolts are finger-tightened initially.
3. Attach the support posts for the upper bunk to the lower bunk frame.
4. Assemble the upper bunk frame and carefully lift it onto the support posts. Secure all connections.
5. Install the guardrails on the upper bunk.
6. Install the ladder securely to the upper bunk.
7. Insert the mattress slats into both bunk frames.
8. Once all components are in place, fully tighten all bolts and fasteners using the appropriate tools. Do not overtighten.
9. Place Queen size mattresses on both bunks.

## OPERATING AND USAGE GUIDELINES

---

To ensure safe and long-lasting use of your bunk bed, adhere to the following guidelines:

- **Weight Distribution:** Distribute weight evenly across both bunks. Avoid concentrating heavy loads in one area.
- **Ladder Use:** Always use the provided ladder for accessing the top bunk. Do not climb on the frame.
- **Guardrails:** Ensure guardrails are always in place and securely fastened on the top bunk.
- **Clearance:** Maintain adequate clearance around the bunk bed, especially for the top bunk, to prevent accidental bumps.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure proper air circulation around mattresses to prevent moisture buildup.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and ensure the safety of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the metal frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
- **Fastener Check:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Retighten as necessary, but do not overtighten.
- **Slat Inspection:** Inspect the mattress slats regularly for any signs of damage or wear. Replace any broken or

weakened slats immediately.

- **Ladder Security:** Ensure the ladder remains securely attached to the bunk bed frame.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your bunk bed.

### Issue: Squeaking Noises

If the bunk bed produces squeaking noises:

- **Check Fasteners:** The most common cause of squeaking is loose fasteners. Systematically check and tighten all bolts and screws throughout the frame.
- **Lubrication:** Apply a small amount of silicone spray or paraffin wax to the joints where metal components meet, especially where slats rest on the frame.
- **Level Surface:** Ensure the bed is placed on a level surface. Uneven flooring can put stress on the frame, leading to noise.

### Issue: Instability or Wobbling

If the bunk bed feels unstable or wobbles:

- **Re-tighten All Bolts:** Ensure all assembly bolts are fully tightened.
- **Verify Assembly:** Double-check that all components were assembled correctly according to the instruction manual. Incorrect placement of parts can affect stability.
- **Floor Leveling:** Use shims under the bed legs if your floor is uneven.
