Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Monitor does not power on.	No power supply; loose connection.	Check power source and all electrical connections. Ensure the circuit breaker is not tripped.
No image/signal on display.	Incorrect signal connection; source device off.	Verify signal cable connections. Ensure the connected source device is powered on and functioning correctly.
Remote control not responding.	Remote batteries depleted; obstruction.	Replace remote control batteries. Ensure no objects are blocking the signal path between the remote and the monitor.
