1. INTRODUCTION

The Playmobil Children's Hospital Room (Model 70192) is designed to provide an engaging and imaginative play experience for children. This manual provides essential information for the assembly, operation, and care of your playset, ensuring safe and enjoyable use.

WARNING: CHOKING HAZARD. Contains small parts and a small ball. Not suitable for children under 3 years due to potential choking risks. Adult supervision is recommended during assembly and play.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

The Playmobil Children's Hospital Room (Model 70192) includes the following components:

- Two figures (nurse, child patient)
- Hospital bed with wheels
- Rolling medical monitor and cart
- Bedside table
- Bandage stickers
- Removable cast
- Teddy bear
- Balloon
- Crutch
- Slippers
- Backpack
- Cup and spoon
- Various other small medical accessories
- Instruction booklet (this manual)

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Playmobil Children's Hospital Room requires careful attention. It is recommended that an adult supervises or assists with the assembly process, especially due to the presence of numerous small parts.

Step-by-Step Assembly

1. Unpack all components from the box. Verify all parts are present against the included parts list, typically found on the packaging or a separate sheet.
2. Follow the pictorial instructions provided in the separate assembly guide. Pay close attention to the diagrams for correct placement and orientation of each piece.
3. Attach stickers as indicated in the instructions. Ensure surfaces are clean and dry before applying stickers for best adhesion.
4. Assemble the hospital bed, medical monitor, and bedside table according to the detailed diagrams.
5. Connect any smaller accessories to the figures or playset as shown in the assembly guide.
6. *Note: Assembly may take a significant amount of time due to the number of small parts. Organizing parts before beginning can facilitate the process.*

4. OPERATING THE PLAYSET

Engaging with the Playset

- **Figures:** Position the nurse and child patient figures in various roles and scenarios within the hospital room setting.
- **Hospital Bed:** Place the child figure in the bed for rest or examination. The bed features functional wheels for easy movement within the playset area.
- **Medical Monitor:** The rolling medical monitor can be positioned next to the bed to simulate patient vital sign checks and medical procedures.
- **Accessories:** Utilize the teddy bear, balloon, removable cast, crutch, and other medical accessories to enhance play scenarios and storytelling.
- **Bedside Table:** Use the bedside table to store small accessories or place items like the cup and spoon for the patient.

- **Storage:** Store the playset and its small parts in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Consider using a dedicated container or bag for small accessories to prevent loss.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all parts for any signs of damage, such as cracks or broken pieces. Discontinue use of any damaged parts to prevent potential injury.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues

- **Missing Parts:** If any parts are missing upon unboxing, please contact Playmobil customer support with your product model number and proof of purchase.
- **Difficulty Assembling:** Refer to the pictorial instructions in the assembly guide carefully. Ensure correct orientation of parts and apply gentle pressure. Adult assistance is highly recommended for complex steps.
- **Lost Small Parts:** Due to the small size of many components, it is easy for them to get lost. Always store small parts securely in a designated container when the playset is not in use.
