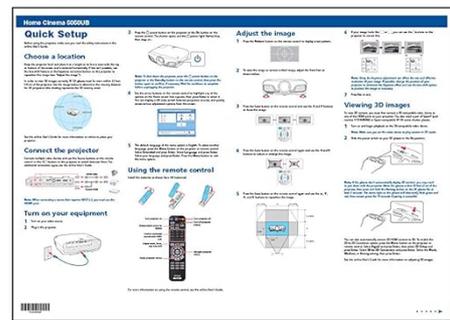

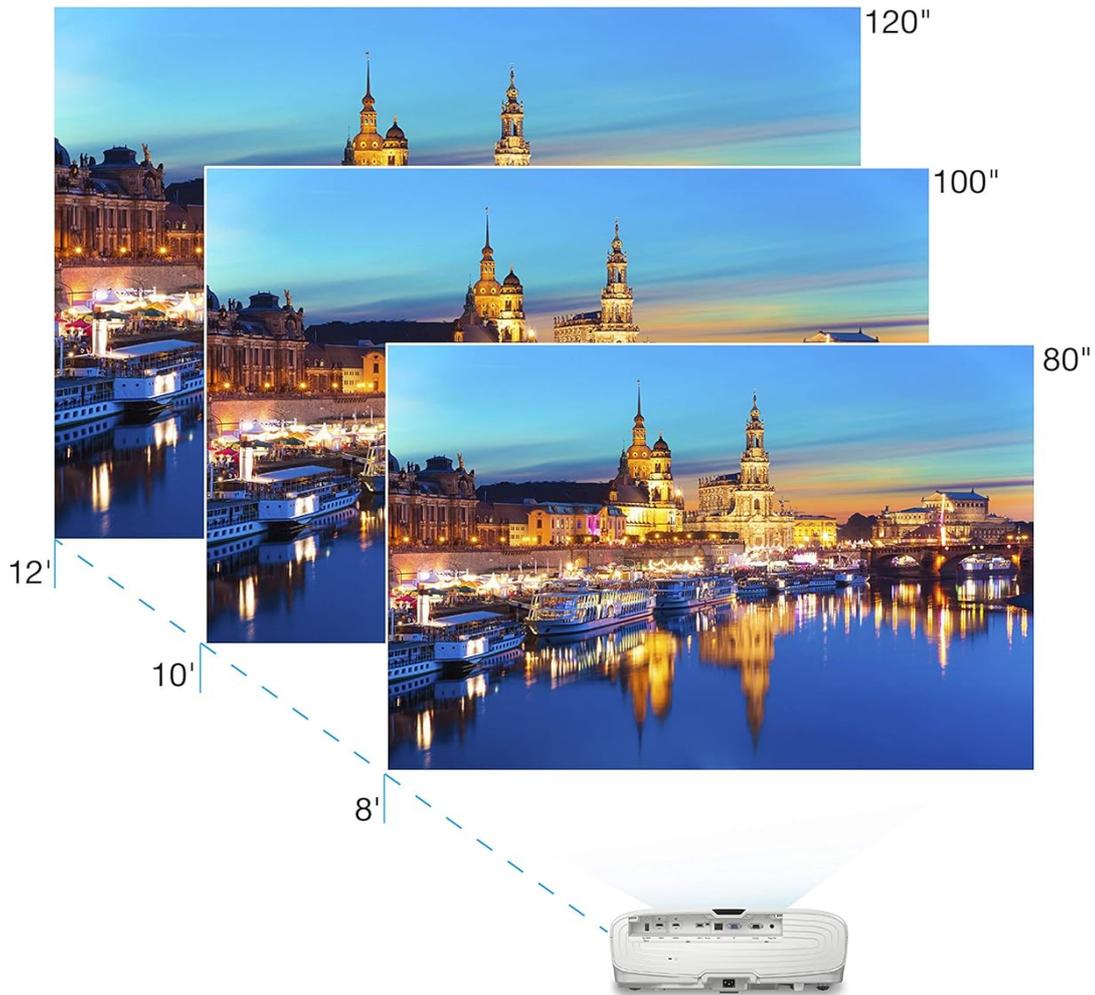


Figure 3: Projection distance guide for various screen sizes.

SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Epson Home Cinema 5050UB projector:

1. **Placement:** Position the projector on a stable surface or mount it to the ceiling. Ensure it is centered with your projection screen.
2. **Power Connection:** Connect the supplied power cord to the projector's power inlet and then to a grounded electrical outlet.
3. **Connect Devices:** Use HDMI cables to connect your video sources (e.g., Blu-ray player, streaming device, game console) to the HDMI ports on the back of the projector. The projector supports various connectivity options.
4. **Initial Power On:** Press the power button on the projector or remote control to turn on the unit.
5. **Image Adjustment:** Use the lens shift, zoom, and focus controls to adjust the image size and clarity on your screen. Refer to the Quick Setup Guide for detailed instructions on these adjustments.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the projector is set up, follow these steps for daily operation:

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the power button on the remote control or the projector's control panel to turn the unit on or off. Allow a few moments for the projector to warm up or cool down.

2. **Source Selection:** Use the 'Source' button on the remote or control panel to cycle through available input sources (HDMI 1, HDMI 2, etc.) until your desired device's image appears.
3. **Menu Navigation:** Press the 'Menu' button to access the projector's settings. Use the arrow keys to navigate and 'Enter' to select options. Adjust settings such as picture mode, color temperature, and aspect ratio as needed.
4. **Volume Control:** Adjust the volume using the dedicated volume buttons on the remote control.
5. **Lens Adjustments:** Fine-tune focus and zoom using the rings around the lens. Use the lens shift dials (if applicable) to vertically or horizontally adjust the image position without moving the projector.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your projector:

- **Cleaning the Lens:** Gently wipe the projector lens with a non-abrasive, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical surfaces. Do not use liquid cleaners directly on the lens.
- **Cleaning the Air Filter:** Periodically clean or replace the air filter to prevent overheating and maintain image quality. Refer to the Quick Setup Guide for filter location and replacement instructions.
- **Lamp Replacement:** The projector lamp has a finite lifespan. When the lamp indicator lights up or the image becomes dim, replace the lamp according to the instructions in the user manual. Always use genuine Epson replacement lamps.
- **General Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the projector with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your projector, try the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Image:** Ensure all cables are securely connected and the correct input source is selected. Check if the lens cap is removed.
- **Dim Image:** Verify the lamp mode setting (e.g., Eco mode might reduce brightness). Check the lamp life and replace if necessary. Ensure the air filter is clean.
- **Blurred Image:** Adjust the focus ring on the lens. Ensure the projector is placed at the correct distance from the screen and the screen surface is flat.
- **Overheating Warning:** Ensure the projector's vents are not blocked and there is adequate airflow around the unit. Clean the air filter.
- **Remote Control Not Working:** Check and replace the batteries in the remote control. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the projector's sensor.
