SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

- Phillips head screwdriver (not included)

Assembly Steps (General Overview):

1. Unpack all components and verify against the parts list in the Assembly Guide.
2. Attach the wheels to the car body, ensuring they are securely fastened.
3. Install the steering wheel and connect any necessary wiring for interactive sounds.
4. Attach the backrest and safety rails.
5. Secure the push handle to the rear of the car.
6. Ensure all screws and fasteners are tightened before use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Modes of Operation:

- **Stroller Mode:** For younger children, the push handle allows parents to control the direction and movement. The safety rails and foot platform provide security and comfort.
- **Walker Mode:** As the child grows, the push handle can be removed, allowing the child to use the car as a walker, pushing it forward while holding onto the backrest.
- **Push-Car Mode:** For independent toddlers, the push handle and safety rails can be removed, allowing the child to propel the car using their feet.

Interactive Features:

- **Horn:** Press the designated button on the steering wheel to activate the horn sound.
- **Music:** Press other buttons on the steering wheel to play various tunes.
- **Storage Compartment:** Lift the seat to access the storage area for small items.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the car with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the car in a dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use.
- **Inspection:** Regularly check all screws, bolts, and connections to ensure they are tight and secure.
- **Battery Replacement (for sounds):** If the interactive sounds become faint or stop working, replace the batteries in the steering wheel compartment. Refer to the Assembly Guide for battery type and replacement instructions.

Car does not move smoothly.	Wheels are dirty or obstructed.	Clean wheels and remove any debris.
Interactive sounds are not working.	Batteries are low or incorrectly installed.	Replace batteries with new ones, ensuring correct polarity.
Parts feel loose after assembly.	Screws or fasteners are not tightened.	Re-tighten all screws and fasteners according to the Assembly Guide.




