INTRODUCTION

The Google Pixel 3 is an unlocked cell phone featuring 64GB of internal memory. This device is designed to capture high-quality photos, facilitate tasks with the Google Assistant, and provide all-day battery performance. Key features include advanced camera capabilities, efficient battery management, and integrated Google services. SETUP

1. Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove all items from the packaging. Inspect the device for any visible damage. Ensure all listed components are present.

2. Insert SIM Card

1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of your Pixel 3.
2. Insert the provided SIM tool into the small hole on the tray to eject it.
3. Place your Nano-SIM card into the tray with the gold contacts facing down.
4. Gently push the tray back into the device until it clicks into place.

3. Power On and Initial Configuration

1. Press and hold the Power button on the side of the device until the Google logo appears.
2. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, connect to a Wi-Fi network, and sign in with your Google Account.
3. You will be guided through setting up security features like fingerprint unlock and screen lock.

OPERATING YOUR DEVICE

1. Navigation and User Interface

- **Touchscreen Interaction:** Navigate through menus, open apps, and interact with content using taps, swipes, and pinches.
- **Gestures:** Utilize intuitive gestures for quick actions, such as swiping up from the bottom for the app drawer or swiping down from the top for notifications and quick settings.

2. Camera Features

The Pixel 3 camera is equipped with advanced features to enhance your photography experience.

- **Group Selfies:** Capture wider group photos without a selfie stick.
- **Portrait Mode:** Create professional-looking portraits with blurred backgrounds.
- **Top Shot:** Automatically recommends the best shot, ensuring smiles and no blinks.
- **Unlimited Photo Storage:** Enjoy free, unlimited storage for all your photos and videos in high quality with Google Photos.

3. Google Assistant

Access your Google Assistant for quick help and information.

- **Activate:** Squeeze the sides of your phone or use your voice by saying "Hey Google" or "Ok Google."
- **Commands:** Ask questions, set reminders, make calls, get directions, and more.

4. Battery Management

- **Fast Charging:** The Pixel 3 supports fast charging with the included 18W USB-C Power Adapter.
- **Wireless Charging:** Place your device on a compatible wireless charger for convenient power.
- **Adaptive Battery:** The phone intelligently limits battery usage for infrequently used apps to extend battery life.

5. Call Screening

Utilize Call Screen to manage unwanted calls.

- **Screen Calls:** Let Google Assistant answer unknown calls and provide a real-time transcription of the conversation.
- **Block Callers:** Block spam, scams, and other nuisance calls directly from the Call Screen interface.

6. Google Lens

Point your camera at objects to get more information.

- **Search:** Look up clothing, home decor, and other items.
- **Text Recognition:** Copy and translate text from images.
- **Identification:** Identify landmarks, plants, and animals.

7. Digital Wellbeing

Manage your screen time and focus on important activities.

- **App Timers:** Set daily limits for app usage.
- **Wind Down Mode:** Automatically turn your screen to grayscale and silence notifications to prepare for sleep.

MAINTENANCE

1. Software Updates

Your Pixel 3 runs on Android and Chrome OS. Ensure your device is always up-to-date with the latest software versions for optimal performance and security. Updates are typically delivered over-the-air (OTA).

2. Cleaning Your Device

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean your screen and device body. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

3. Battery Care

To prolong the life of your Lithium Polymer battery, avoid exposing it to extreme temperatures and use only official or certified charging accessories.

TROUBLESHOOTING

1. Performance Issues

- **Slow Performance/App Crashes:** Restart your device. Clear app caches or uninstall infrequently used apps. Ensure sufficient storage space is available.

2. Battery Drain

- **Excessive Drain:** Check battery usage in settings to identify power-hungry apps. Reduce screen brightness, disable unnecessary features like always-on display, or activate Battery Saver mode.

3. Connectivity Problems

- **Bluetooth/Wi-Fi/GPS:** Toggle the respective feature off and on. Restart your device. Forget and reconnect to networks.

4. Screen Issues

- **Unresponsive Screen:** Restart your device. If the issue persists, consider a factory reset (backup data first).
- **Screen Burn-in:** While OLED screens can experience this, it's often mitigated by software. Avoid static images on screen for extended periods.





