# RGEEK FMCB 64MB Memory Card for PlayStation 2 User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

The RGEEK FMCB 64MB Memory Card is designed for PlayStation 2 (PS2) consoles, pre-installed with Free McBoot (FMCB) software. This card enables your PS2 to boot various applications directly, facilitating the use of games and media from USB drives or internal hard drives (with appropriate adapters). It offers an enhanced way to utilize your PS2 console.

## 2. SETUP

---

### 2.1 Inserting the Memory Card

To begin, ensure your PlayStation 2 console is powered off. Locate an available memory card slot on the front of your PS2 console. Gently insert the RGEEK FMCB 64MB Memory Card into the slot until it clicks securely into place. The card is designed for a 'plug and play' experience on most compatible PS2 models.

## 2.2 Initial Boot

Once the memory card is inserted, power on your PlayStation 2 console. The system should automatically boot into the Free McBoot menu, presenting you with various application options. If the system boots to the standard PS2 browser, please refer to the Troubleshooting section.

## 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The RGEEK FMCB Memory Card comes pre-loaded with several useful applications. Upon booting your PS2 with the card inserted, you will be presented with the FMCB menu. Navigate through the menu using your PS2 controller's directional pad and 'X' button to select options.

### 3.1 Key Applications

- **uLaunchELF (uLE):** A powerful file browser and launcher for the PS2. It allows you to manage files on memory cards, USB drives, and network shares.
- **Open PS2 Loader (OPL):** Enables loading games from a USB drive, network share, or internal hard drive (requires a network adapter for fat models).
- **HDLoader:** An application for installing and launching games from an internal hard drive (requires a

network adapter for fat models).

- **USB Advance:** Facilitates playing games from a USB storage device.
- **Simple Media System (SMS):** A media player for the PS2, capable of playing various video and audio formats.
- Other emulators and utilities may also be present, such as GSM (Graphics Synthesizer Mode Selector), PS2InfoGB, FCEU Packed (NES emulator), PGEN (Genesis emulator), SNES-Station (SNES emulator), and GBA TempGBA (Game Boy Advance emulator).

## 4. MAINTENANCE

---

To ensure the longevity and reliable performance of your RGEEK FMCB Memory Card, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Keep Clean:** Periodically clean the metal contacts of the memory card with a dry, lint-free cloth to prevent dust and debris buildup.
- **Store Properly:** When not in use, store the memory card in a protective case or a clean, dry environment away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.
- **Handle with Care:** Avoid dropping the card or subjecting it to physical impact, which can damage internal components.
- **Proper Insertion/Removal:** Always insert and remove the memory card gently and correctly from the PS2 slot to prevent damage to both the card and the console.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### 5.1 Compatibility Information

The RGEEK FMCB 64MB Memory Card is designed to be compatible with most PlayStation 2 consoles. However, specific models may have limitations or require additional hardware for certain functionalities. Please consult the compatibility table below for detailed information regarding various PS2 models and their support for FMCB and related applications.

#### Important Notes on Compatibility:

- The product is generally compatible with all PS2 consoles except for specific SCPH-9XXXX models with a 230 BIOS version.
- The table indicates that SPCH-1XXXX, SPCH-1800X, and SPCH-3XXXX models do *not* support FMCB directly. For SPCH-3XXXX, HDLoader may be supported with a Network Adapter.
- SPCH-5XXXX, SPCH-7XXXX, and SPCH-9XXXX (with BIOS below 230) models are listed as supporting FMCB.
- If your console is an SCPH-30001 model, the product description states it may not work. Please verify your specific PS2 model and BIOS version for optimal compatibility.

## 5.2 Common Issues and Solutions

- **Card Not Recognized:** Ensure the memory card is fully and correctly inserted into the PS2 memory card slot. Try inserting it into the other memory card slot if available. Clean the contacts as described in the Maintenance section.
- **PS2 Boots to Standard Browser:** If the FMCB menu does not appear, verify your console's compatibility using the table above. Some PS2 models, particularly early fat models (SPCH-1XXXX, SPCH-1800X, SPCH-3XXXX), may not directly boot FMCB.
- **Application Errors:** If a specific application (e.g., OPL) fails to launch or function correctly, ensure your USB drive or hard drive is formatted correctly and contains compatible game files. Consult online resources for specific application usage guides.
