INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your Kaz FS614 The Steam Facial for Face. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the device and retain it for future reference. This product is designed to provide a soothing steam experience for facial and hair care.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always keep the steamer away from children. Do not leave the device unattended while in operation. Allow the steamer to cool down before handling or refilling the water tank. Be cautious of hot steam to prevent burns or scalding.

- Ensure the device is placed on a stable, flat, heat-resistant surface during use.
- Do not immerse the unit in water or other liquids.
- Unplug the device from the power outlet when not in use, before cleaning, and before adding or removing parts.
- Do not operate the device with a damaged cord or plug, or if it has malfunctioned or been damaged in any manner.
- Use only distilled or demineralized water to prevent mineral buildup and prolong the life of the unit.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, and other objects away from the steam vent during operation.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Upon opening the package, please verify that all components are present and in good condition. The Kaz FS614 The Steam Facial for Face typically includes:

- 1 x Main Steamer Unit
- 1 x Facial Mask Attachment
- 1 x Power Cord (integrated)
- 1 x Instruction Manual (this document)

SETUP

- 1. **Placement:** Place the main steamer unit on a firm, level, and heat-resistant surface. Ensure it is away from any edges or flammable materials.
- 2. **Water Filling:** Carefully remove the facial mask attachment. Locate the water reservoir. Fill the reservoir with clean, distilled, or demineralized water up to the indicated maximum fill line. Do not overfill.
- 3. **Attachment:** Securely place the facial mask attachment back onto the main unit. Ensure it is properly seated to prevent steam leakage.
- 4. Power Connection: Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Preparation:** Ensure the unit is set up as described in the "Setup" section.
- 2. **Power On:** Turn on the device using the power switch (if present, otherwise plugging it in might activate it). The indicator light should illuminate.
- 3. Heating: Allow a few minutes for the water to heat up and steam to begin generating.
- 4. Facial Steaming: Once steam is consistently produced, position your face comfortably over the facial mask attachment, maintaining a safe distance to avoid direct contact with hot surfaces or concentrated steam. Close your eyes during the steaming process.
- 5. **Duration:** Steam for the recommended duration, typically 5-10 minutes. Adjust based on personal comfort.
- 6. Power Off: After use, turn off the device and unplug it from the power outlet.
- 7. Cool Down: Allow the unit to cool completely before attempting to move, clean, or store it.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your steamer.

- 1. Unplug and Cool: Always unplug the steamer and allow it to cool down completely before cleaning.
- 2. Empty Water: Carefully remove the facial mask attachment and empty any remaining water from the reservoir.
- 3. **Wipe Surfaces:** Use a soft, damp cloth to wipe the exterior surfaces of the main unit and the facial mask attachment. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- 4. **Descaling (Monthly):** To prevent mineral buildup, especially if using tap water (though distilled water is recommended), perform descaling monthly.
 - Mix a solution of equal parts white vinegar and water.
 - Pour the solution into the water reservoir.
 - Allow it to sit for 20-30 minutes (do not turn on the unit with this solution).
 - Empty the solution and rinse the reservoir thoroughly with clean water several times.
 - · Wipe dry.
- 5. Storage: Store the clean, dry unit in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and out of reach of children.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Kaz FS614 steamer, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution	
No steam produced.	No water in reservoir.Unit not plugged in or powered on.Mineral buildup.	Fill reservoir with water.Ensure unit is plugged in and power switch is ON.Perform descaling procedure.	
Low or inconsistent steam.	Insufficient water.Mineral buildup.Facial mask attachment not seated correctly.	 Add more water (up to max fill line). Perform descaling procedure. Re-seat the facial mask attachment firmly. 	
Water leaking from unit.	 Overfilled reservoir. Facial mask attachment not seated correctly.	Do not overfill the reservoir.Re-seat the facial mask attachment firmly.
