INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the operation and maintenance of your Sharp LED Digital Alarm Clock. Designed for simplicity and ease of use, this clock features a large, easy-to-read LED display, a built-in night light, and intuitive front-panel controls. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper function and longevity.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure the clock is placed on a stable, flat surface to prevent falling.
- Do not expose the clock to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, or high humidity.
- Keep the clock away from water or other liquids. Do not immerse in water.
- Use only the specified power source (corded electric).
- For battery backup, use one 9V battery (not included). Do not mix old and new batteries or different types of batteries.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the clock yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.
- Keep out of reach of small children to prevent accidental ingestion of small parts or batteries.

SETUP

1. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet. The LED display will illuminate.
2. **Battery Backup (Optional):** For power outage protection, insert one 9V battery (not included) into the battery compartment located on the bottom of the clock. This will retain time and alarm settings during a power interruption, though the display will go blank.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Setting the Time

1. Press and hold the **TIME** button located on the front panel. The hour digits will begin to flash.
2. While holding the **TIME** button, press the **HOUR** button repeatedly to advance the hour. Observe the PM indicator to ensure correct AM/PM setting.
3. Continue holding the **TIME** button and press the **MINUTE** button repeatedly to advance the minute.
4. Release the **TIME** button to set the current time.

Setting the Alarm

1. Press and hold the **ALARM** button located on the front panel. The alarm hour digits will begin to flash.
2. While holding the **ALARM** button, press the **HOUR** button repeatedly to set the alarm hour. Observe the PM indicator for correct AM/PM setting.
3. Continue holding the **ALARM** button and press the **MINUTE** button repeatedly to set the alarm minute.
4. Release the **ALARM** button to set the alarm time.

Activating/Deactivating the Alarm

- To turn the alarm **ON**, slide the **ALARM ON/OFF** switch to the "ON" position. An alarm indicator light will appear on the display.
- To turn the alarm **OFF**, slide the **ALARM ON/OFF** switch to the "OFF" position. The alarm indicator light will disappear.

Using the Snooze Function

- When the alarm sounds, press the large **SNOOZE** bar on the front of the clock. The alarm will temporarily stop and sound again after approximately 9 minutes.
- The snooze function can be pressed repeatedly until the alarm is manually switched off.

Using the Night Light

- To turn the night light **ON**, slide the **NIGHTLIGHT ON/OFF** switch to the "ON" position. The top panel of the clock will illuminate.
- To turn the night light **OFF**, slide the **NIGHTLIGHT ON/OFF** switch to the "OFF" position.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** To clean the clock, gently wipe the surface with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents as they may damage the finish.
- **Battery Replacement:** If using battery backup, replace the 9V battery annually or when the clock fails to retain settings during a power outage. Ensure proper polarity when inserting the new battery.
- **Storage:** If storing the clock for an extended period, disconnect it from the power outlet and remove the battery. Store in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Display is blank.	No power or power outage.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. If there was a power outage, the display will return when power is restored (if battery backup is not used).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Alarm does not sound.	Alarm is not set or alarm switch is OFF.	Verify the alarm time is set correctly. Ensure the ALARM ON/OFF switch is in the "ON" position.
Time/Alarm settings are lost after power interruption.	No 9V battery installed or battery is dead.	Install a fresh 9V battery for battery backup. Replace the battery if it is old or depleted.
Night light does not turn on.	Night light switch is OFF.	Ensure the NIGHTLIGHT ON/OFF switch is in the "ON" position.
