Introduction

Safety Information

WARNING: Choking Hazard - Small Parts. Not for children under 3 years.

Always supervise young children during play. Ensure all track connections are secure before operating. Do not use damaged components. Keep the track and cars away from water and excessive heat.

Setup

Follow these steps to assemble your Carrera First Mario Kart race track:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging.
2. **Assemble Track:** Connect the track sections by aligning the tabs and pressing them firmly together until they click. Refer to the diagram below for a typical track layout.
3. **Install Batteries:** The track requires 4 Type C batteries (not included). Open the battery compartment on the power connection track section and insert the batteries, observing correct polarity (+/-).

4. **Connect Controllers:** Plug the speed controllers into the designated ports on the power connection track.
5. **Place Cars:** Position the Mario and Yoshi slot cars onto their respective track slots. Ensure the guide pins on the bottom of the cars are properly seated in the track groove.
6. **Add Accessories:** Place the spinners and other track decor as desired to enhance your racing experience.

Operating Instructions

Once the track is set up and cars are in place, you're ready to race!

- Power On:** Ensure the power switch on the connection track is in the 'ON' position.
- Control Speed:** Use the handheld speed controllers to accelerate your car. Press the button to increase speed and release to slow down. Experiment with different pressure levels to master cornering and avoid derailing.
- Race:** Compete against a friend or sibling. The electronically regulated speed controllers make it easy for young children to manage their cars.
- Spinners:** Drive through the spinner sections for an added challenge and fun visual effect.

Maintenance

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your race track:

- **Cleaning:** Regularly wipe down track sections with a dry, soft cloth to remove dust and debris. Clean the car's guide pins and contact brushes periodically to ensure good electrical connection.
- **Storage:** When not in use, disassemble the track and store all components in their original packaging or a suitable container to prevent damage.
- **Battery Care:** Remove batteries from the power connection track if the set will not be used for an extended period to prevent leakage.

Troubleshooting

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Car Not Moving:**
 - Check if batteries are correctly installed and have sufficient charge.
 - Ensure all track connections are firm and secure.

- Verify that the car's guide pin is properly seated in the track slot and the contact brushes are making good contact with the track rails.

- Car Derails Frequently:**

- Reduce speed, especially when entering curves. The electronically regulated speed controllers allow for precise control.
- Ensure track sections are laid on a flat, stable surface.
- Check for any debris on the track or car that might impede smooth movement.

- Intermittent Power:**

- Inspect all track connections for looseness.
- Clean the metal contacts on the track sections and the car's brushes.
