INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions on how to set up, operate, and maintain your watch to ensure its longevity and optimal performance.

The Stauer Compendium Hybrid Watch is designed with a robust alloy case and a durable stainless steel band, featuring a range of functions including a stopwatch, alarm, and a blue backlight for enhanced visibility.

COMPONENTS AND CONTROLS

INITIAL SETUP

Your Stauer Compendium Hybrid Watch comes with a battery installed. Before first use, you may need to remove a plastic stopper from the crown if present. Follow these steps to set the time and date.

Setting Analog Time

1. Pull the crown (the knob on the side of the watch) out to the first or second click position (refer to your watch's specific crown positions).
2. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the analog hands to the correct time.
3. Once the analog time is set, push the crown back in to its original position to start the watch movement.

Setting Digital Time and Date

The digital display features three LCD windows. Specific button functions may vary slightly, but generally involve a 'Mode' button and 'Adjust'/'Set' buttons.

1. Press the 'Mode' button (usually on the bottom left) repeatedly to cycle through different digital modes: Time, Date, Alarm, Stopwatch.
2. When in the desired setting mode (e.g., Time or Date), press and hold the 'Adjust' or 'Set' button (usually top left or right) until the digits begin to flash.
3. Use the 'Increment' or 'Next' button (usually bottom right) to change the flashing digit or move to the next setting.
4. Once all settings are correct, press the 'Adjust' or 'Set' button again to confirm and exit the setting mode.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Stauer Compendium Hybrid Watch offers several useful functions.

Using the Stopwatch (Chronograph)

1. Press the 'Mode' button until the digital display shows the stopwatch function (usually indicated by 'STW' or 'CHRO').
2. Press the 'Start/Stop' button (often top right) to begin timing.
3. Press the 'Start/Stop' button again to pause the timing.
4. Press the 'Reset' button (often bottom right) to clear the stopwatch to zero.

Setting the Alarm

1. Press the 'Mode' button until the digital display shows the alarm function (usually indicated by 'ALM').
2. Press and hold the 'Adjust' button until the alarm time digits flash.
3. Use the 'Increment' button to set the desired alarm hour and minute.
4. Press 'Adjust' again to confirm.
5. To activate or deactivate the alarm, press a dedicated 'Alarm On/Off' button or a combination of 'Mode' and 'Increment' buttons (refer to your watch's specific button layout).

Using the Backlight

Your watch features a blue backlight for improved visibility in low-light conditions.

- Press the 'Light' button (often top right or a dedicated button) to illuminate the digital display. The backlight will typically stay on for a few seconds.

Rotating Bezel Function

The rotating bezel can be used for various timing purposes, such as tracking elapsed time.

- Rotate the bezel to align the zero marker with the minute hand at the start of an event.
- Read the elapsed time on the bezel as the minute hand progresses.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care will help maintain the appearance and functionality of your watch.

Water Resistance

Your Stauer Compendium Hybrid Watch is water-resistant up to 3 ATM (30 meters). This means it is suitable for daily use and can withstand splashes of water or brief immersion, such as during hand washing or rain exposure. **It is not suitable for bathing, swimming, diving, or any water sports.** Avoid pressing buttons while the watch is wet or submerged.

Cleaning

- Wipe the watch case and band regularly with a soft, dry cloth to remove dirt and oils.
- For the stainless steel band, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by a dry cloth. Avoid using harsh

chemicals or abrasive materials.

Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a single battery. When the display dims or the watch stops functioning, it may be time for a battery replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and water resistance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your watch, try these common solutions:

- **Watch not running or digital display is blank:** Check if the crown is fully pushed in. If not, the battery may be depleted and needs replacement.
- **Analog and digital times do not match:** Re-set both the analog and digital times following the instructions in the 'Initial Setup' section.
- **Buttons are unresponsive:** Ensure the watch is dry. If the issue persists, a battery replacement might be necessary, or there could be an internal malfunction requiring professional service.
- **Condensation under the crystal:** This may indicate a breach in the water resistance. Avoid further water exposure and seek professional repair immediately.
