PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Dancover Gazebo Osiris 3x4m is designed to provide a versatile and elegant outdoor living space. It features a robust steel frame, a ventilated roof, and a dual curtain system including both mosquito nets and solid side walls. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your gazebo.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Careful assembly is crucial for the stability and longevity of your gazebo. It is recommended that at least two adults perform the assembly. Ensure all components are present before beginning.

Component Checklist:

- Steel frame components (legs, beams, roof supports)
- Roof canopy fabric
- Mosquito net curtains (4 pieces)
- Solid side wall curtains (4 pieces)
- Curtain hangers and rings
- Assembly hardware (bolts, nuts, washers)
- Tools (e.g., wrench, screwdriver - typically not included)

Assembly Steps:

1. **Unpack and Identify:** Carefully unpack all components and lay them out. Refer to the parts diagram (if available in physical manual) to identify each piece.
2. **Assemble the Base Frame:** Connect the horizontal base beams to the vertical leg posts using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are secure but do not fully tighten bolts until the frame is complete.
3. **Construct the Roof Frame:** Assemble the roof support beams and connect them to the top of the leg posts. The "Heavy duty steel frame construction" ensures stability.
4. **Attach the Roof Canopy:** Drape the main roof canopy over the assembled roof frame. Secure it according to the design, ensuring the "Ventilation system on the roof" is properly aligned.
5. **Install Curtain Rails:** Attach the "Double aluminium curtain rail with easy glide function" to the inside of the frame.
6. **Hang Curtains:** Attach the mosquito net curtains and solid side wall curtains to the curtain rails using the "Easy to attach the curtain with hangers". The dual rail system allows for flexible arrangement.
7. **Final Tightening:** Once the entire structure is assembled and aligned, fully tighten all bolts and connections.
8. **Secure to Ground:** For added stability, especially in windy conditions, secure the gazebo to the ground using stakes or weights (not included).

OPERATING YOUR GAZEBO

The Dancover Gazebo Osiris offers flexible options for privacy and insect protection.

Curtain System:

Your gazebo is equipped with a unique "Double aluminium curtain rail with easy glide function" allowing you to use both mosquito nets and solid side walls simultaneously. Each set of curtains can be operated independently.

- **Mosquito Nets:** Use these to protect against insects while maintaining airflow and visibility. They can be zipped closed for full enclosure.
- **Solid Side Walls:** These provide privacy and additional protection from sun, wind, or light rain. They also feature "Curtains with zip opening" for easy access.

To open the curtains, simply slide them along the rail and secure them with the integrated tie-backs. To close, release the tie-backs and slide the curtains to meet, then zip them closed if desired.

Roof Ventilation:

The gazebo features a "Ventilation system on the roof" designed to allow hot air to escape, reducing heat buildup and improving air circulation within the gazebo.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your Dancover Gazebo.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the fabric canopy and curtains with mild soap and water. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry completely before storage.
- **Frame Care:** Inspect the steel frame periodically for any signs of rust or damage. Clean and touch up any scratched areas with rust-inhibiting paint. Ensure all bolts remain tight.
- **Weather Precautions:** While designed for outdoor use, it is recommended to remove the canopy and curtains during strong winds, heavy rain, or snow to prevent damage to the structure.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, especially during winter months, disassemble the gazebo and store all components in a dry, protected area to prevent weather damage and prolong product life.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Gazebo feels unstable.	Loose connections; not properly anchored.	Ensure all bolts are fully tightened. Secure the gazebo to the ground using appropriate stakes or weights.
Curtains do not slide smoothly.	Debris in rail; damaged hangers; misaligned rail.	Clean the "Double aluminium curtain rail" of any dirt. Check hangers for damage. Verify the rail is properly installed and level.
Water pooling on roof.	Improper canopy tension; heavy rainfall.	Ensure the canopy is stretched tautly over the frame. In heavy rain, consider removing the canopy to prevent damage.


