INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your Firefly A 230 Kick Scooter. Please read it thoroughly before assembly, operation, or maintenance. Keep this manual for future reference.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always prioritize safety when operating the scooter. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage.

- Always wear appropriate safety gear, including a helmet, knee pads, and elbow pads.
- Ensure all clamps and fasteners are securely tightened before each ride.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 100 kg.
- Ride on smooth, dry surfaces away from traffic.
- Avoid riding in wet conditions, at night, or in low visibility.
- Children should be supervised by an adult.
- Familiarize yourself with local laws and regulations regarding scooter use.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Firefly A 230 Kick Scooter features a practical folding mechanism for easy storage and transport. Follow these steps for initial setup.

1. Unfolding the Scooter:

Locate the folding mechanism near the base of the handlebar stem. Release the locking lever and carefully unfold the scooter until the stem clicks into its upright position. Ensure the locking mechanism is fully engaged and secure.

2. Adjusting the Handlebar Height:

The handlebar is individually adjustable to suit rider heights between 1.55 m and 1.95 m. Open the quick-release clamp on the handlebar stem. Adjust the handlebar to a comfortable height, ensuring the safety pin engages in one of the adjustment holes. Close the quick-release clamp securely.

3. Brake Check:

Verify that the handbrake is functioning correctly. Squeeze the brake lever and ensure it effectively slows and stops the rear wheel. Adjust cable tension if necessary (refer to maintenance section).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Starting:

Place one foot firmly on the deck of the scooter. Use your other foot to push off the ground, gaining initial momentum.

2. Riding:

Once moving, place both feet on the deck, one behind the other, or side-by-side if comfortable. Steer by leaning and gently turning the handlebars. The large 230mm wheels and ABEC-5 bearings provide a smooth and fast ride.

3. Braking:

To slow down or stop, use the handbrake located on the handlebar. Apply gentle, consistent pressure to the lever. For emergency stops, apply the handbrake firmly while maintaining balance.

4. Parking:

The scooter features a parking function without a stand. To park, simply fold the scooter using the folding mechanism. This allows for compact storage when not in use.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your scooter.

- **Cleaning:**

Wipe the scooter clean with a damp cloth after each use. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Ensure the non-slip grip on the deck is free from dirt and debris.

- **Wheel and Bearing Inspection:**

Periodically check the 230mm wheels for wear and tear. Ensure the ABEC-5 ball bearings spin freely. If they become noisy or stiff, they may require cleaning or replacement.

- **Brake Adjustment:**

If the handbrake feels loose or ineffective, the cable tension may need adjustment. This typically involves tightening the barrel adjuster near the brake lever or at the brake caliper. Consult a professional if unsure.

- **Fastener Check:**

Regularly inspect all bolts, nuts, and clamps for tightness. Re-tighten any loose fasteners to prevent accidents.

- **Storage:**

Store the scooter in a dry, cool place, away from direct sunlight and moisture. Utilize the folding mechanism for compact storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Scooter feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose handlebar clamp or folding mechanism.	Ensure all clamps and the folding mechanism are fully engaged and tightened.
Brake is not effective.	Loose brake cable or worn brake pad.	Adjust brake cable tension. Inspect brake pad for wear and replace if necessary.
Wheels are noisy or do not spin freely.	Dirty or damaged ABEC-5 bearings.	Clean bearings or replace them if damaged.
Handlebar slips down after adjustment.	Quick-release clamp not tight enough or safety pin not engaged.	Tighten the quick-release clamp. Ensure the safety pin is fully engaged in an adjustment hole.
