1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Vacmaster DVTB204 Professional 4-Gallon 20V Cordless Wet/Dry Shop Vacuum. Please read all instructions carefully before using the product to ensure proper function and to prevent injury or damage.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using this appliance to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Read All Instructions: Familiarize yourself with the vacuum's features and operation before use.
- **Battery Safety:** Use only the specified battery and charger. Do not expose batteries to water, heat, or direct sunlight. Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- **Proper Use:** Do not vacuum flammable or combustible liquids, hot ashes, or sharp objects. Ensure the correct filter is installed for wet or dry applications.
- **Supervision:** This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities unless supervised or instructed concerning its use.
- Maintenance: Disconnect the battery before performing any maintenance or cleaning.

4. ASSEMBLY AND SETUP

Follow these steps to assemble your vacuum and prepare it for use.

- 1. **Install Filter:** For dry vacuuming, ensure the washable HEPA-material cartridge filter is securely installed over the filter cage. For wet vacuuming, remove the cartridge filter and install a foam filter (sold separately) or ensure the filter cage is clean.
- 2. **Attach Hose:** Insert the flexible hose into the vacuum port on the front of the unit until it clicks into place.
- 3. **Attach Accessories:** Connect the desired extension wands and nozzle (e.g., Car/Utility Nozzle, Crevice Tool) to the end of the hose.
- 4. **Charge Battery:** Insert the 20V Lithium-Ion battery into the quick charger. Plug the charger into a standard electrical outlet. The indicator light on the charger will show charging status. Ensure the battery is fully charged before first use.
- 5. **Insert Battery:** Once charged, slide the battery into the battery compartment on the vacuum until it locks securely.

5. OPERATION

5.1 Dry Vacuuming

For dry debris, ensure the cartridge filter is clean and properly installed. Turn the vacuum ON using the power switch. Guide the nozzle over the area to be cleaned. The vacuum is designed for efficient pickup of dust, dirt, and small debris.

5.2 Wet Vacuuming

Before wet vacuuming, remove the cartridge filter. A foam filter (sold separately) is recommended for wet pickup to protect the motor. Turn the vacuum ON. Guide the nozzle over liquid spills. The tank has a maximum fill line; do not exceed this to prevent motor damage. Empty the tank immediately after wet pickup.

5.3 Blower Function

To use the blower function, detach the hose from the vacuum port and attach it to the blower port located on the side of the unit. Turn the vacuum ON. This function is useful for clearing debris from workshops, driveways, or other areas.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your vacuum.

6.1 Emptying the Tank

After each use, especially after wet vacuuming, unlatch the tank and carefully lift the motor head assembly. Dispose of collected debris or liquid. Clean the inside of the tank with a damp cloth if necessary.

6.2 Filter Cleaning and Replacement

The HEPA-material cartridge filter can be washed with water. Allow it to air dry completely before reinstallation. Replace the filter if it is damaged or if suction power significantly decreases even after cleaning. Always use a clean filter for dry vacuuming.

6.3 General Cleaning

Wipe the exterior of the vacuum with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Ensure all

ports and accessories are free from blockages.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your vacuum, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum does not turn on	Battery not charged or improperly inserted; Power switch OFF	Charge battery fully and ensure it is securely inserted; Turn power switch ON
Low suction power	Clogged filter; Full tank; Hose or nozzle blockage; Loose hose connection	Clean or replace filter; Empty tank; Clear any blockages; Ensure hose is securely connected
Motor stops during wet pickup	Tank is full (float mechanism activated)	Empty the tank immediately
Battery not charging	Charger not plugged in; Faulty battery or charger	Ensure charger is plugged into a working outlet; Contact customer service for battery/charger issues
