4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

- 2. Locate Piping Rail: Identify the piping rail located on the front lead bar of your awning.

- 3. **Insert Front Wall:** Carefully slide the keder (beading) of the Fiamma Blocker Pro 250 front wall into the awning's piping rail. Ensure it is evenly distributed across the width of the awning.
- 4. **Secure to Ground:** Once the front wall is in place, use the provided anchoring stakes to secure the ground extension firmly to the ground. This prevents the wall from lifting in the wind and ensures stability.
- 5. Check Stability: Verify that the front wall is taut and securely anchored. Adjust as necessary.

- The large transparent window allows natural light into the enclosed area while offering protection from wind and light rain.
- The ground extension helps to seal the area, reducing drafts and providing a more contained space.
- The front wall can be easily removed by reversing the installation steps when not needed.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your Fiamma Blocker Pro 250:

- Cleaning: The vinyl material is washable. Clean with mild soap and water. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or stiff brushes, as these can damage the material or its UV-resistant coating.
- **Drying:** Always ensure the front wall is completely dry before folding and storing to prevent mildew and odors.
- Storage: Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Difficulty Inserting into Rail:** Ensure the piping rail is clean and free of debris. Apply a silicone-based lubricant if necessary to ease insertion.
- Front Wall Not Taut: Re-check the positioning in the piping rail and ensure all anchoring stakes are securely fastened and tensioned.
- Water Accumulation: Ensure the awning itself is pitched correctly to allow water runoff. The front wall is water-repellent but not designed to hold standing water.
