MAAX Sax Oval Fiberglass Soaking Bathtub Model 105797-000-002 User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe installation, operation, and maintenance of your MAAX Sax Oval Fiberglass Soaking Bathtub, Model 105797-000-002. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning installation or use to ensure proper function and longevity of your product. Retain this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Important Safety Instructions:

- Installation must comply with all local plumbing and building codes.
- Ensure the floor structure can support the weight of the bathtub when filled with water and a bather.
- Always use appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) during installation.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or tools that could damage the fiberglass surface.
- Ensure all connections are watertight to prevent leaks and water damage.
- Children should be supervised when near the bathtub.
- Avoid extreme temperatures or harsh chemicals that may compromise the material integrity.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The MAAX Sax Oval Fiberglass Soaking Bathtub is designed for a comfortable bathing experience. It features a maximized bathing well and a comfortable backrest. This model is a two-piece design, facilitating easier transport and installation.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Professional installation is recommended for this product to ensure proper function and adherence to all local codes. The bathtub's two-piece design aids in transport and positioning.

4.1 Site Preparation

- Ensure the installation area is clean, level, and structurally sound to support the bathtub's weight.
- Verify that plumbing for the drain and water supply lines are correctly positioned according to the bathtub's specifications.

4.2 Positioning the Bathtub

Carefully move the two pieces of the bathtub into the desired location. The adjustable leveling legs should be used to ensure the bathtub is perfectly level on all sides. Adjust each leg individually until stability is achieved.

4.3 Drain and Faucet Connection

- Connect the end drain to the existing plumbing. This model is compatible with Above-the-Floor Rough (AFR) and F2 Drain systems.
- Install the chosen faucet (deck-mounted or floor-mounted) according to the faucet manufacturer's instructions. Ensure all water supply connections are secure and leak-free.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your MAAX Sax Soaking Bathtub is straightforward. Ensure the drain is closed before filling.

- **Filling the Bathtub:** Turn on the faucet to the desired water temperature and fill the bathtub. Do not overfill.
- **Bathing:** The bathtub features a maximized bathing well and a comfortable backrest for an ergonomic soaking experience.
- **Draining the Bathtub:** Open the drain to empty the bathtub after use.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and proper care will maintain the appearance and extend the life of your fiberglass bathtub.

6.1 Cleaning the Surface

- Use a soft cloth or sponge with a non-abrasive, mild liquid cleaner.

- Rinse thoroughly with clean water after cleaning to remove all cleaner residue.
- Avoid using abrasive powders, steel wool, or harsh chemical cleaners (e.g., acetone, paint thinner, strong acids or bases) as these can damage the fiberglass finish.

6.2 Drain Maintenance

- Periodically check the drain for hair or debris accumulation and clear as necessary to ensure proper drainage.
- Avoid pouring harsh drain cleaners directly into the bathtub, as they may affect the finish.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your bathtub.

- **Slow Drainage:** Check the drain for obstructions (hair, soap scum). Use a drain snake or a mild drain cleaner if necessary. If the problem persists, consult a plumber.
- **Leaks:** Inspect all plumbing connections for tightness. If a leak is detected at the drain or faucet connections, tighten them carefully. If the leak originates from the bathtub body, contact MAAX customer support.
- **Surface Stains:** For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive cleaner specifically designed for fiberglass or acrylic surfaces. Follow the cleaner's instructions carefully.


Figure 8.1: The MAAX Sax Bathtub integrated into a contemporary bathroom design.






