2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Contender C18400-C6 is a 60-inch tall storage cabinet designed for various environments such as classrooms, offices, and homes. It features a natural finish and is constructed from durable Baltic Birch Plywood.

Key Features:

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

This cabinet requires assembly. It typically ships in multiple boxes and assembly can take approximately 3-4 hours. Basic tools such as a screwdriver and possibly a drill may be required.

Assembly Steps (General Guidelines):

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all parts and hardware. Verify all components are present against the packing list (not provided in this manual).
2. **Assemble Base:** Attach the casters to the base of the cabinet. Ensure all screws are tightened securely. Note: Some pre-drilled holes for casters or other components may require adjustment or additional drilling for proper alignment.
3. **Construct Frame:** Assemble the side panels, back panels, and top panel using the provided mortise and hex screw joinery. Ensure all connections are firm and stable.
4. **Install Shelves:** Insert the adjustable shelves into the desired positions.

5. **Attach Doors:** Mount the doors to the cabinet frame. Ensure hinges are properly aligned for smooth operation.
6. **Install Locking Mechanisms:** Attach and test the door locking mechanisms. If a lock does not function as designed (e.g., latch piece is too short), adjustments or replacement may be necessary.
7. **Secure to Wall:** Using the provided anti-tip hardware, securely fasten the cabinet to a wall stud. This step is crucial for safety.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Opening and Closing Doors:

- To open, unlock the door using the provided key (if applicable) and gently pull the handle.
- To close, push the door firmly until it latches. Ensure it is securely closed to prevent accidental opening.

Adjusting Shelves:

- The cabinet features adjustable shelves. To reposition a shelf, remove all items from the shelf.
- Carefully lift the shelf and remove the shelf pins from their current holes.
- Reinsert the shelf pins into the desired new holes, ensuring they are level.
- Place the shelf back onto the pins, ensuring it is stable before placing items on it.

Mobility:

- The cabinet is equipped with casters for easy movement.
- To move the cabinet, ensure doors are closed and locked, and all items are stable.
- Gently push the cabinet to its new location. Avoid sudden movements or pushing over uneven surfaces.

5. MAINTENANCE

Cleaning:

- The cabinet features a Tuff-Gloss UV Finish, which is designed for easy cleaning and stain resistance.
- Wipe surfaces clean with a soft cloth dampened with mild soap and water.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or solvents, as these can damage the finish.
- Dry immediately with a clean, soft cloth to prevent water spots.

General Care:

- Regularly check all screws and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Tighten as needed to maintain structural integrity.
- Inspect hinges and locking mechanisms periodically for smooth operation and wear.
- Avoid exposing the cabinet to extreme temperature changes or high humidity, which can affect wood products.

- Do not overload shelves beyond their capacity to prevent warping or damage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Door Alignment Issues:

- If doors do not close properly or appear misaligned, check the hinge screws. Loosen slightly, adjust the door position, and then re-tighten.
- Ensure the cabinet is on a level surface. Uneven flooring can cause doors to sag or not close correctly.

Lock Mechanism Malfunction:

- If a lock mechanism does not engage or secure the door, inspect the latch piece. It may be too short or misaligned.
- Adjust the position of the lock mechanism or the strike plate on the cabinet frame. If the part is defective, contact customer support for a replacement.

Cabinet Instability:

- Ensure all assembly screws are fully tightened.
- Verify the cabinet is placed on a flat, stable surface.
- Confirm the anti-tip hardware is correctly installed and secured to a wall stud.
