1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Targus W620 Wireless Optical Mouse. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your mouse to ensure optimal performance and longevity. The Targus W620 offers reliable 2.4 GHz wireless connectivity, a precise 1600 DPI optical sensor, and a compact design suitable for both office and mobile use.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your Targus W620 Wireless Optical Mouse.

- **Left Click Button:** Standard primary click function.
- **Right Click Button:** Standard secondary click function.
- **Scroll Wheel:** For vertical scrolling and middle-click function.
- **DPI Button:** Adjusts the mouse sensitivity (DPI).
- **Optical Sensor:** Located on the bottom, detects mouse movement.
- **Battery Compartment:** Located on the bottom, holds two AAA batteries.
- **USB Receiver Storage:** A dedicated slot on the bottom for storing the USB receiver when not in use.

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your Targus W620 Wireless Optical Mouse:

1. Install Batteries:

- Locate the battery compartment cover on the bottom of the mouse.
- Slide the cover open.
- Insert the two AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
- Close the battery compartment cover securely.

2. Connect USB Receiver:

- The USB receiver is typically stored in a slot on the bottom of the mouse for transport. Gently remove it.
- Plug the USB receiver into an available USB port on your computer.

3. Power On:

- There is no explicit power switch on this model; the mouse activates upon movement and connection.
- Your computer should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. This may take a few moments.
- Once drivers are installed, the mouse is ready for use.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Targus W620 Wireless Optical Mouse is designed for intuitive use. Here are its primary functions:

- **Basic Navigation:** Move the mouse on a flat surface to control the cursor on your screen.
- **Left Click:** Use for selecting items, opening files, or activating functions.
- **Right Click:** Use for accessing context menus or secondary functions.
- **Scroll Wheel:** Rotate the wheel to scroll vertically through documents and web pages. Press the scroll wheel for a middle-click function, often used for opening links in new tabs or auto-scrolling.

- **DPI Adjustment:** Press the DPI button (located behind the scroll wheel) to cycle through the available DPI settings (800, 1200, 1600 DPI). This changes the sensitivity of the mouse cursor. A higher DPI means the cursor moves further with less physical mouse movement.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your mouse.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the exterior of the mouse. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Optical Sensor:** Keep the optical sensor area on the bottom of the mouse clean and free from dust or debris to ensure accurate tracking.
- **Battery Replacement:** When the mouse performance degrades or stops responding, it is likely time to replace the batteries. Follow the steps in Section 4.1 to replace the two AAA batteries.
- **Storage:** When transporting or storing the mouse, always place the USB receiver back into its dedicated storage slot on the bottom of the mouse to prevent loss.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Targus W620 mouse, try the following solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Mouse not responding or cursor not moving.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Ensure batteries are correctly installed and not depleted. Replace if necessary. ◦ Check that the USB receiver is securely plugged into a working USB port on your computer. Try a different USB port. ◦ Ensure the mouse is within range of the USB receiver (typically up to 10 meters). ◦ Restart your computer.
Cursor movement is erratic or jumpy.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Clean the optical sensor on the bottom of the mouse. ◦ Use the mouse on a clean, non-reflective, and uniform surface. Avoid glass or highly reflective surfaces. ◦ Check for interference from other wireless devices.
DPI button not changing sensitivity.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Ensure the mouse has power and is connected. ◦ Press the DPI button firmly. There should be a noticeable change in cursor speed.
Wireless connection issues.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Move the mouse closer to the USB receiver. ◦ Remove any large metal objects or electronic devices that might be causing interference between the mouse and receiver. ◦ Try plugging the USB receiver into a different USB port, preferably one directly on the computer rather than a hub.
