Lack Wall Shelf Unit Instruction Manual

Model: Lack Wall Shelf Unit | Brand: Lack

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Lack Wall Shelf Unit is designed to efficiently utilize wall space, providing ample storage without occupying significant room area. Its shallow depth makes it ideal for various settings. This unit can be mounted either horizontally or vertically to suit your spatial requirements.

Key features include a white stained oak effect finish, providing a wood-like appearance, and a versatile design that allows it to function as a stand-alone shelving unit when properly secured.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING:

- Always secure the shelf unit to the wall using the appropriate wall anchoring device. Incorrect installation may cause the shelf to fall, leading to injury or property damage.
- Screws for wall mounting are not included. Different wall materials require different types of fixing devices. Use fixing devices suitable for the walls in your home. If you are uncertain about what type of mounting devices to use, please contact your local hardware store.
- Do not exceed the specified weight limits:
 - Maximum load when hung horizontally: **55 lbs (25 kg)**.
 - Maximum load per shelf when hung vertically: **6 lbs (3 kg)**.

Overloading may cause the shelf to break or collapse.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

This product requires assembly. Please follow the steps below carefully. It is recommended to have two people for assembly and installation.

3.1 Unpacking and Component Check

1. Carefully unpack all components from the packaging.
2. Verify that all parts are present and undamaged by comparing them with the included parts list (not provided in this manual, refer to original packaging).

3.2 Assembly Steps

1. Identify the main vertical support and the individual shelf pieces.
2. Attach each shelf to the main vertical support according to the pre-drilled holes and included fasteners. Ensure each shelf is securely fastened before proceeding.
3. Once assembled, determine your desired mounting orientation (horizontal or vertical).

3.3 Wall Mounting

1. Select a suitable wall location, considering the weight limits and the type of wall material.
2. Using appropriate wall anchoring devices (not included), secure the shelf unit firmly to the wall. Ensure the unit is level before tightening all fixings.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Lack Wall Shelf Unit is designed for displaying and storing various items. Observe the following guidelines for optimal use:

- **Horizontal Mounting:** When the unit is mounted horizontally, the total maximum load capacity is 55 lbs (25 kg). Distribute weight evenly across the shelves.
- **Vertical Mounting:** When the unit is mounted vertically, each individual shelf has a maximum load capacity of 6 lbs (3 kg). Avoid placing excessively heavy items on single shelves.
- Place items carefully to prevent them from falling or damaging the unit.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To maintain the appearance and longevity of your Lack Wall Shelf Unit, follow these simple care instructions:

- Wipe clean using a damp cloth and a mild cleaner.
- Wipe dry immediately with a clean, dry cloth to prevent moisture damage.

- Avoid using abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the finish.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Lack Wall Shelf Unit, consider the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Shelf feels unstable or wobbly.	Ensure all assembly screws are tightened. Verify that the wall anchoring devices are securely installed and appropriate for your wall material.
Items sliding off shelves.	Check if the unit is level. Ensure items are placed centrally and not overhanging the edges. Avoid placing items that are prone to rolling or tipping without additional support.
Damage to shelf surface.	Avoid placing hot or sharp objects directly on the surface. Use coasters or protective pads under items that might scratch or stain. Refer to maintenance instructions for cleaning.




Figure 4: Product dimensions for the Lack Wall Shelf Unit.
